Nathaniel Bronner: Welcome to Brothers of The Word because brother, you need the word.

And today, I am going to first of all say I'm only talking to adults. If you're under 18, turn off the television, turn the channel right now because this is some adult stuff that I'm about to say and this is not for children.

We're getting ready to have a series here at the Ark of Salvation called Bedroom Talk. Let me tell you what Bedroom Talk is all about.

In the Christian world, we have some issues and we have some issues in relationships and you know we have some issues in relationship. It's so indicative of what is happening in the Christian world that we, as Christians, are having such a difficulty in our bedrooms. We're having trouble within our relationships and the statistics are grim and they are rather distressing. The statistics tell us that the Christians have a higher divorce rate than those who are not Christian and it should not be so. The series Bedroom Talk is going to be talked by my younger brother James and his wife, Stephanie. And the reason that they are teaching this, it's been prophesied, it's been laid upon their hearts, but yet, they have some unique experience in the bedroom that they're going to share with you. That's why I told you if you're under 18, turn the channel right now because I'm getting ready to say some stuff that is only for adults and in this series, it's only going to be for married adult, it's not for children, but they saw on your screen right now. But they are going to be teaching us some things about relationship. Now, they've had six kids in eight years. You know they got some bedroom experience. They've had six kids in eight years and they've experienced some things that you generally will not hear from the pulpit because oftentimes, a pulpit won't tell you stuff at your bedroom, but yet, we deal with the discretions every day. We have the same urges, the same hormones, the same physical needs as everyone else and we got the same sexual functions and dysfunctions as everyone else, but no one wants to talk about this stuff openly. So, that's why we're going to have a series that's going to teach you and going to show you some things and right now, we're getting ready to go into that bedroom right now and they're going just tell you some of the things that they're going to be talking about. So, just stay and

listen and right now, we're getting ready to go into their bedroom.

Now, anointing always comes from the head down and for those of you who've been watching me for any length of time, one thing that people always say about is, "Pastor brother you just tell stuff straight" and I do. I don't try to coat it, I don't try to sugar it up, I just tell the truth and I just tell it straight. I see that is rule of adults on my brother James and his wife, Stephanie. And as I look at over the list of some of the things they're going to be talking about, one of the subjects they're going to be talking about --- it's got about a dozen different things that they're going to be telling you in your life and how to get your intimate life together, how to smooth some stuff out, one of the things is called how to turn a three-minute brother into a 30-minute lover. Now, that's a neat one. That's a date and there's a whole list of dates to just like it. So, it's real bedroom talk from a Christian perspective, from experience because people -- I don't care how we try to cover it up, we have some problems in our intimate lives and in our intimate world and that's why I had to read this prayer request from a pastor. Pastors have problems because pastors don't even know how to handle their bedroom problem. So, you need to listen and learn and you need to be here on these dates. You need to be here on every one of these dates, but this time, for the first time, we're having live internet webcast so you can go to airjesus.com and actually listen live from the internet, but there will be anointing that will be present here that won't be present on the internet. They're going to ask you to do some things and to bring some things here and you're going to hear that when we get into that bedroom. But this is what Bedroom Talk is going to be about because you need to know this and if you're married and if you have any issues whatsoever, or if you want to just get your intimate personal relationship with your husband or with your wife better, you need to be in the bedroom and you need to be here for Bedroom Talk.

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Now, let's get ready right now and then follow me. Come on, come on. We're getting ready to go right now. We're getting ready to go straight to that bedroom.

I am Pastor Nathaniel Bronner and just as I promised, we're getting ready to go over to James and Stephanie's bedroom and they're going to tell you some things about what's coming up on Bedroom Talk. Now, right now, we're in my house and we're not going to drive over, we're going to walk over. I'll explain it.

All right, here we go. We're not going to drive. We're going to walk over to James' house. The Bible says in Psalms 133, "How good and pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together." And we literally live on the same street and the same subdivision, only a few houses apart. You see, the brothers, we dwell together in unity and as a result, we dwell together with our wives in unity. So, it's a part of family unity and we're going to go --- we're going to see some of the marriage secrets that James and Stephanie is going to share with us in Bedroom Talk. Let's go.

As you all know, from those of you who've been watching us on television, this is my brother, C. Elijah. He's going to join us today as we go over to James and Stephanie, just to see what they've got to tell us.

The Bronner brothers, six brothers, one mother and one father, all of us married, no divorces in the family. That is not by accident, that is by design. It is something that we grew up with, that we learned, that we saw in our own households. How to keep a marriage together and the pressures of life, they can really get tough on you. I mean, with children, money issues, health issues, stuff just happening. To be honest about it, sex issues, all kinds of issues, you name it, it happens, just plain and simple as that and yes, because you are Christian, it does not mean the stuff does not happen, it still happens, but we don't know how to deal with it and they're going to tell you some things that my father told us and there are some things that they're going to tell you that you've not heard in any other marriage seminars. You need to be at Bedroom Talk. You see the dates on the screen. You see where it is on your screen. Whatever you are doing on those dates, you need to be in Bedroom Talk. It will change your relationship. It will change your marriage. It will bring some new intimacy into what may be a stale situation. You know, marriage is the highest and the happiest form of human relationship and particularly, your special marriage the way God intend it. Marriage is something as a gift from God and God wants us to be happy in marriage, to enjoy one another for the comfort of one another and to have a

partner in life. And I'm just so happy that Bedroom Talk is coming to change our marriages, to revolutionize our relationships and you're going to be excited, you're going to be happy and this is going to change your marriage forever. You'll never be the same and we're excited.

Yes, we are really excited about Bedroom Talk. Both of us, we do a lot of marital counseling. So, we know firsthand the difficulties and the pressures and all of the problems that people are facing in the church and so often, they long for an answer for an example for real issues and to be perfectly honest with you people, some of these issues are really sticky, they're really delicate to talk about and it's uncomfortable to really talk about them in the church. And straight talk as I am, I'd be honest, some of this stuff is real twitchy to talk about, but people need the knowledge. Now, I know you want to know when this is, it's right there on your screen, where it is, it's right there on your screen. Bedroom talk, just a preview of what you're going to get and if you notice here, even on the door, there is an image of a host as a threshold, the symbol of Jesus. Make sure it's in your home. Let's ring the doorbell. Let's get ready to go inside.

We are here right now and just as I promised and they're getting ready to show you into that bedroom, into some secret things, into some secret places. To give you some marriage secrets that's going to bring the love back, it will bring the intimacy back and it will bring the peace and the joy in your relationship like you'd never had before.

We're in the bedroom now of James and Stephanie Bronner. You'll just have a seat as we just talk and kind of go over a little bit about what you all are going to be doing in Bedroom Talk. First of all, where did you all come up with the name, Bedroom Talk?

James Bronner

Well, we chose Bedroom Talk because first of all, the bedroom, it's the most intimate place of marriage and the place of intimacy has great power. Even in the Bible, the woman even with the issue of blood when she touched the hem of Jesus' garment. He healed her in an intimate place and that blood flow stopped when she touched the hem of that garment. So, we want to bring some healing into the intimate places of people's marriages. So, that's why we chose the bedroom because it's the most intimate place out of every room of the house, out of every area of your life. The most intimate moments happen in the bedroom and it's also a place of beginning and endings. It's the place where you wake up in the morning and start your day first off. You wake up in the bedroom. After all of the duties are done during the day and the children are fed and work is done, the bedroom is the place you go to retire for the day. So, it's the place of beginning, ending and it's a doorway to a new day. So, you can just get the beginning and ending of a day right then, everything in the middle will be a lot better. So, bedroom is the first place of intimacy and it's also a place where the most pleasurable memories of life are made and we all know what I'm talking about. And we'll get into there a little later, but it's the most pleasurable moment's placed, but it's also a place where the most horrific moments or memories are made. The worse arguments happen in the bedroom. Sometimes, abuse, it happens in the bedroom. So, when the children sometimes hear mother and father fighting and fighting as is usually common out of the bedroom. So, some of the worst memories happen in the bedroom as well as some of the best. It is also the place of birth, you know. The bedroom is pretty much where we all came

into this world and you got a few exceptions however, that's the place of conception, so. And that's one of the reasons why the devil is after the bedroom and it's a battleground among Christians. So, he's taking it not only from -- we weren't about rocking the other places in the world where there is war, but the bedroom is the new war ground and battleground. You have husband and wife that are soldiers in their own house and the bedroom that's saying there come in to bring division between husband and wife. So, we're trying to bring that intimate place to a place of healing.

Nathaniel Bronner Now, what are some of the things that you all are going to be talking about in Bedroom Talk? Just give us some brief synopsis of some of the stuff, just quickly.

James Bronner We're going to try to make this a very comprehensive study on marriage and we're going to go through a lot of things and this is not only chain through ---

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--- our years of marriage to each other, but we wanted to make sure that we had old and new and we call both of our parents who had 40 and 50-year marriages. We've been through marriage retreats every year. We wrote countless books on the subject and we studied the word and prayed about it. So, combined all of these different areas and resources together to make sure we didn't miss anything and even when we got through listing everything for the series, we called several pastors who had done a lot of marital counseling and we told them the issues that we'd be addressing and asked them are we missing anything that you dealt with over 40, 50 years of pasturing? So, by the time we got all of the points and that they said they've never seen a case that we're not going to be dealing with. So, we're going to be dealing with some areas also that you never heard in a marriage type of a seminar for finance as one of the subjects that I'm going to be dealing with is how to turn a three-minute Bronner into a 30-minute Bronner.

Nathaniel Bronner Wow! That's a lot of people saying, wow! from a pastoral standpoint. A lot of couples, that's the real issue. What are some of the other things you're going to be talking about?

James Bronner Some of the other things that we're going to be talking about is how to renew passion in the relationship and not only renew it, but even we're going to give some keys to take it to a whole new level that the couples have never experienced before. If you have noticed even in our physical bedroom, we have a fireplace and in the fireplace, there's a path of light that burns 24 hours a day. They never go without. It burns seven days a week. So, and that's how the passion should be in relationships, it shouldn't go through ups and downs and, you know, you got cold beds this week and hot beds the next week. It should be some passion burning at all times. So, another area that we're going to deal with is the passion area.

Nathaniel Bronner What about money? Because that's one of the big issues. Another thing is, (00:17:17) have you heard any money issue, you're going to deal with any of that?

Stephanie Bronner: Oh yes.

James Bronner: I'll let my wife talk about that.

Stephanie Bronner: Well, we will talk about budgeting and how I had a problem with the monthly budget, how the money was spent for the month, but the month wasn't over. And I had to learn some things. I had to apply some principles. I had to make sound decisions and even go back into my history of where I came from with my parents and the things that are in their background and it actually has helped me to understand better why I had trouble saving money, why I had trouble with money just leaving my hands and I was only buying the essentials. So, I would like to share with you some of wonderful principles that I had applied to my life that allowed me to budget better and allowed for my husband's stress level to not be so high.

Nathaniel Bronner Well basically, you're pregnant right now. So, in just short period of time, you had six kids, so six individual births, no twins. Six kids and eight years of marriage which meant that you were pregnant a lot. There were some issues dealing with intimacy. Just tell me, what are you going to deal with just even--because a lot of people can't handle it when they're just pregnant with one child, two children. You all have basically delivered six children in eight years. So, what just are some of the --- the real talk, the real issues that you'd had to deal with in that period of time, deal with six kids in eight years.

Stephanie Bronner: Can I talk first? Well, the most amazing thing is, I had an understanding that my husband needs to be satisfied even though I am many times unable to physically satisfy him sexually. And I had to come up with some ideas. I had to use my imagination. I had to talk to some of my friends, some of my girlfriends that really had wonderful bedroom relationships that are Christians and I got some wonderful, wonderful tips.

Nathaniel Bronner You're going to tell all of that?

Stephanie Bronner: Yes.

Nathaniel Bronner That will be amazing!

Stephanie Bronner A wonderful information about just how to handle and satisfy your husband even when you're physically unable, be it with pregnancy. There are other female issues, menstruation as well as --- just problems that we had as females that come up and many times, there's medical reasons that you cannot perform, but that doesn't mean he has to go out hungry and try to seek someone else's table to feed from.

Nathaniel Bronner: And that's one of the reasons why Bedroom Talk is first of all adults only, second of all married couples only, because a lot of single people want this knowledge too, but that's not where it is supposed to be used. So, this is 18 plus, 18 years and older and it's for married couples to be used with each other.

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Nathaniel Bronner: So, we want to make that very clear, but you got to be there early because this is going to be packed out. It's going to be live webcast, it's going to be off the chain. You need to be able to have Bedroom Talk.

Let's just talk about some of the other things that you all are going to talk about and deal with during Bedroom Talk.

James Bronner Well, doing a great (00:20:21) communication and there are so many couples today that are -- I mean, just fussing and fighting all of the time and the smallest thing just sets them off. I mean, the husband leaves the toilet seat often. I mean, it's just all day long the wife is not speaking, so, at a certain level of tension, I

mean, it just creates a coldness over relationships. So, we're going to be talking about how to smooth the tension in relationships, how to communicate and get these things out. So, we're going to give some conflict resolution techniques and a lot of the things that we're saying that a lot of you might be saying, well, they don't sound very spiritual. They're all biblically based. We're going to show you where they are in the Bible, but we want to give you some things that we know that have worked for thousands of marriages all over the country. So, we're going to give you actual techniques on things that you can implement that you'll get manifested results in your marriages.

Nathaniel Bronner I see you have a book, show them the book, that's bedroom topic put all of these in a book, you can get the book --- you all do remember the website, don't you? airjesus.com. So, go to airjesus.com, get all of the information and for whatever reason you can't make it or if you do make it and you can't get in, get the book, get the tape, get the CD series at airjesus.com. What about infidelity and people who had past ties and old flames and that kind of thing, are you going to deal with that and how the couples can handle that and deal with that?

Stephanie Bronner Yes. We will go in depth to help you understand soul ties, past and present. We will help you break things that you didn't think were possible to be broken especially old relationships, that one sexual experience that you thought you could never match. We're going to help you alleviate that from your mind so you can press forward and be gratified and very well taken care of by your spouse without having that mental connection from the past. We would really like to help you break that curse and move forward in your marriage.

Nathaniel Bronner Amen. This is an awesome bedroom, just pan the camera around to this bedroom. The bedroom is truly awesome and it has a rather unique design and everything here is significant and I just want you to kind of explain to the people and show the people some of physical items that actually exist within your bedroom, so they could actually know how you have this bedroom laid out and why it is laid out and what everything in it means. What's that? Their own to be it. First of all, what is this?

Stephanie Bronner This is the blessed anointed oil that the Lord has truly been good to us with. We have been praying over this oil nightly

before we sleep, that the presence of the Holy Father will be upon it at the actual Bedroom Talk series. When we are in the pulpit, we're going to actually have your pillowcases, we're going to cover your pillowcases to be anointed

Nathaniel Bronner So, you want people to actually bring their real pillowcases that they sleep on?

Stephanie Bronner: Yes.

Nathaniel Bronner: What about blankets and comforters and sheets?

Stephanie Bronner: No. We don't want any other items. We only want the item where you lay your head at night. The males can bring theirs and the females as well as if you have a need which all of us do to truly have God's presence in our marriage. We need to have this blessed anointed oil placed in every home because God has truly done a miraculous thing in me. I did not realize that the oil was actually going to bless our union the night we began to pray for it, but I can tell you, as we lay there in our truly divine creation, (00:24:21), if I can be kind of bland, we were laying there and after our experience, God really moved and I had one of the best experiences of our married life. And, I would like to impart that same thing into your bedroom.

Nathaniel Bronner Is there (00:24:37) cost of anything?

Stephanie Bronner: No. It would be absolutely free.

Nathaniel Bronner Absolutely free. All you got to do is get there with a pillowcase. Husband and wife, get there with a pillowcase. (00:24:45).

James Bronner: And we will go through the entire bedroom just like they do at the tavern hopefully and all of the symbols will be there. We're going to go through the bedroom the same way. We're going to relate the bed with things in the marriage. We're going to talk about the dresser and mirror and then tell you what they relate to in your marriage. We're going to talk about the light to tell you what that relates to. We're going to go with the television and the bathroom and the door and the window and we're going to go through all of these things and relate them to areas of your marriage where you can have understanding and it'll make it stick in your memory and every time you see these areas in your

bedroom, you will remember the area it relates to in your marriage.
