Another thing I've seen on the golf course, and he is a priest to lead the power of unity but, in most households, it's not only as they're not unity, but this person inside you act to the opponents. And then, one time, we had a family tournament and my brother, Daryl, he hit his ball in the woods or something and lost it, and I was trying to tell him. I said, "That's a two-point penalty" and he said, "No, that's one point." I said, "No, that's two points. I've been in a lot of tournaments, and we just went back and forth and threw his spirit. He just guess, and I said that's just one point, and he normally would shoot maybe 95 on a round of 18 holes, but he got off fresh grade in some of the thing, and he was just shaking his head all the way through, and he went from a 95 to about to 125.

And after the game was over, I apologized to him and, you know, I was just trying to say the rule but, you know, I wouldn't have thought of that. I didn't know that's going to affect you like that, and it shows me just the power of just pressing with the stuff, and it has an equal power. So, another rule in golf is you supposed to be quiet when people playing it, and they'll have a less sound and quiet please. But even -- imagine if Tiger Woods was playing in the tournament, and somebody was just picking on his ear and just his wax that just flip in it. Imagine how his game would be if he couldn't concentrate. So, that's another thing to keep in mind as we go home and we start the fuzz and fight with our mates and with our children. It throws a long line even the normal performance. So, that's the reverse and flip side of that, but that's where most people are right now. So, keep that in mind, too. As the power differ and has an equal power destructive. So, make sure that we're not on that side.

There's another example that I thought of even with my brothers. My brother, Bishop Daniel, he was playing golf as an amateur. He normally shoots on 9 holes. He normally shoots about 50. He played about once a year, that's all. And there was one time, we went for the family tournament, and he had been in prayer a long time. He didn't play in 12 months, and he normally shoots by 50, and he won that and, at one time a year, the learning was still on. Then, he shot a 36, and he par just like every hole, and he had played in a solid year. We just couldn't believe it. We've looked at him getting ready to play with. He don't mess this one up. He would just hit the ball and

it just goes straight home and far away, and it was something like we have never seen before. So, when God is on your team and playing through you, even though other people might not be able to see you, you got a second partner, but he'll be on the inside giving you peace and swiftly when he give you instructions. You'll be able to perform like you have never seen in your life, but you've got to trust Him, and you got to have Him with you. And I thank God for even the -- just the unity of the brother that we have in this place.
