

1 Hour And 40 Minutes

Sermon Title: **1 Hour and 40 Minutes**

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Well, today is the day that it's one of those messages. And when I praise it indeed today potentially is the message that will change the rest of your life. I meant just that. It's one of those unusual kinds of message. And today I'm going to really speak today about an hour and 40 minutes. Turn to your neighbor next to him and say he's going to speak today about an hour and 40 minutes. And if you'll understand that by the time I'm finished with it, but today I'm going to speak about an hour and 40 minutes. And you see this message was triggered by a telephone call that I received upon last week by a member of the little Holy Ghost Church that I attended for years.

And of the young ladies that attended there, Dora I was very good friends with. We were like brother and sisters. And she really had a couple of dreams about me in the past. And every time she had called me with a dream, the dream always came to pass. So when she called and she left a message on my answering machine and she said "Nathaniel, I had a dream about you and I need to talk with you". So when I get her message knowing the track record of the prior 2 dreams that had come to pass. I called her up. And I said "Dora, what is it? What did you dream?" And she asked me, she said "how have you been feeling?" I said "well, I've been feeling fine". She said "is everything all right?"

And I could tell from the question that she was leading into it. There was something about the dream that worried her. There was something about the dream that concerned her. So I just asked. "Well, just tell me. What did you dream?" And she said "I dreamed that you were all excited and you were all happy 'coz you were getting ready to go to be with the Lord." And she said "I was there in the dream and I was just upset and I was just crying because you were getting ready to go to be with the Lord and you didn't want to stay and you were all excited and you were all happy. And I was just pleading with you to stay. But you didn't want to stay. You were just glad. You were so excited and so happy.

And then looked like you took me and you took my mother and a few other people and you took us up on an airplane and you flew to this place and we landed. And there was this beautiful green meadow. It had grass greener than any place I've ever even seen in real life or even in pictures. It was the most beautiful place that I'd ever seen. And there was a house in the middle of it. And we were there in the house. And I was just pleading with you to stay. But you were so excited. And you were so happy that you were going to be with the Lord." And I told her, I said "Dora really first of all, I'm feeling fine. There's nothing wrong with my body." And I said "Yes, I am going to die. But it ain't no time soon." And I said "What you were dreaming about is true because once you were dreaming about some various things that had been going on within my spirit." And I told her how would it come to pass and I told her.

I said you know that my brother Darrell passed not very long ago. That experience changed my life. And when he passed, God had told me you go and you spend 24 hours with him. And I stayed in the funeral home with the body for 24 hours praying. I was there with my brother James. First time we'd ever stayed up all nightlong. But see there are some situations that will have you up all nightlong. And we were there praying all nightlong, praying for God to resurrect. And as I was there in the middle of the room, in the middle of the night and I was praying and I just asked. I said "Lord, why? This is a good man. Why don't you resurrect him? I started to hear Darrell's voice." Now this is all right, I'm telling you this is kind of strange 'coz some people have never experienced that.

And there are many experiences that are not exactly in the Bible. And I can't explain them to you. I can't make you believe them. I can just tell you what I went through. And I was beginning to hear his voice. And he said, "Man, it's a hundred times better on this side." And he began to explain some things and tell me some things. And even at the point as we got up and James asked so how do you know it was him? I said I don't. He said how do you know that in your mind? I said I don't. And he said why don't you ask something that only he would know. And I asked some things and he told me a few things and when I told the people, they said wow. They said there's no way in the world you could have known that.

Now I still cannot as absolutely say that it was him. But I could absolutely say it wasn't me. And that's the only thing I can absolutely guarantee that it wasn't me because the knowledge that came I had no way of knowing. So I knew it wasn't me. But I believed in my spirit that it was him. But it changed my whole life because you see you have to know my brother Darrell. He had the best of everything. He had the fanciest houses. He had the fanciest clothes. He had the prettiest wife. He had everything. And yet when he got over on the other side, he said it's a hundred times better. The thing changed my whole view of life.

You see when someone transcends this world, we'll say oh they're in a better place. But deep down in our spirit we don't believe. You see we read it in the word that we should rejoice upon death and weep upon birth. We read it but we don't really believe it. Because sometimes deep down all of us cling to life and we really don't really believe it. There was once a preacher and he was preaching with congregation. And he said everybody in the world go to heaven. Come on down. Everybody in the world go to heaven. Come on down. Everybody got up. They're still all in front of the pews and everything. But there was one man sitting back in the back that didn't move.

And so he said everybody in the world go to heaven, come on down. He was looking at the man and the man just sat there. And he was a good member. And finally, he said look, don't you want to go to heaven? He said yeah, but I don't want to go right now. You see. So everybody sometimes we have these views. And so we really and

truly down in our spirit, really and truly down in our spirit, we've got question marks about some things. But after that experience that changed my whole viewpoint. And you see I have a great life myself.

As a matter of fact as I look over my life, my past, my present, and what I believe to be my future, I can honestly say this. I would not trade places even if I had the ability to do so. I would not trade places with a single person on earth. And I mean that from the bottom of my heart. I had a good life. I wouldn't trade with anybody. I wouldn't trade where I've been and I wouldn't trade where I am. I know where I've been. I know where I am. I'm pretty happy with it to be quite honest with you. I wouldn't trade it with anybody. I wouldn't trade it with any superstars. I wouldn't trade it with any billionaire. I would not trade my life even if I could with anybody. So I'm as pleased with my life as you can get.

But yet after going that experience, I understood that it is a hundred times better on the other side. And even as I thought even about the dreams and I thought about the grass and this just came to me this morning. Heaven is about the only place where the grass is really green on the other side. It's about the only place where the grass is really green on the other side. Most of this stuff in this world is really illusion. We think it's all right. We really get it after we had it for a few months and it isn't what we thought it was in the first place. Heaven is about the only place where it's really green on the other side.

And right after that dream as I went home that day, I was in my jeep and I had a lot of mail that I had gotten from the arch and I just happened to open up a package, a big package. And in the package, a lady had written me a long letter. And she had included in the package 2 books. And these were the 2 books written by Mary K. Baxter. One of them is called A Divine Revelation Of Hell and the other is called A Divine Revelation Of Heaven. Now first of all people, I can't tell you whether these 2 books are true or not because they're really not scripts because it goes into describing things that are in hell and things that are in heaven that frankly are not in the Bible because the Bible didn't tell you very much about really either place.

We found that out when we were in Sunday schools and we were discussing what heaven was like. And we were asking each person, what do you think heaven is like. And basically all we really knew that the streets were paved with gold, that there are mansions in heaven and pearly gates. And we figured that well, people would be sitting around all day, sitting around the throne of God, praising God, listening to music, singing hymns all day long. And as I thought about it and as I listened to everyone's viewpoint of heaven, I said you know that sounds just like church. When you really boil it down, most of our images and most of what we really think, it sounded just like church. And that's what we do in church. When

we're in church we're sitting really around in the presence of God and we're praising God and we're in this whole atmosphere.

But the only drawback to that there's no one that I know who wants to spend 24 x 7 in church. As a matter of fact, when I told you today that I was going to speak about an hour and 40 minutes, the first thing that ran through most of your minds is ooh, that's a long time. Now understand this, if you've got a problem thinking that it's a long time to listen to an hour and 40 minutes of the word of God, how in the heaven are you going to spend 24 x 7. Have you ever thought about that?

So really as I looked at the book, I can't tell you whether they're true or not because frankly those descriptions are not in the Bible. But I can tell you this. I think you benefit from reading them. Because it gives you a view. And the lady claims that God took her both into hell and to the heaven so she can come back and tell people what they're like. And I've talked to people that have read the books and they say this. It makes them want to go to heaven. And it scared the hell out of them. So it can benefit you because it will give you some idea because most of you have no idea what even . . . you don't even have a concept of what heaven is really like.

But yet I knew when my brother told me it's a hundred times better than he is, I had to know a whole new viewpoint of heaven. And I want you to open your Bibles to 2nd Corinthian the 5th chapter. And if you can just grasp the message today, it will change your entire view of life and this world. 2nd Corinthian Chapter 5. And I'm going to read the new living translation. So this is going to read a lot different from your King James Version. But the King James Version again the language is sort of arcane that it's difficult to understand clearly what this passage is talking about. It's a popular passage. Most of you have heard it before. But I want you to understand it in a new light.

2nd Corinthian Chapter 5 beginning with the first verse the new living translation. "For we know that when this earth we live in is taken down. When we die and leave these bodies, we will have a home in heaven. An eternal body made for us by God Himself and not by human hands. We grow weary in our present body. And we long for the day when we will put on our heavenly bodies like new clothing. For we will not be spirits without bodies, but we will put on new heavenly bodies. Our dying bodies make us groan inside. But it's not that we want to die and have no bodies. We want to slip into our new bodies so that these dying bodies will be swallowed up by everlasting life.

God Himself has prepared us for this. And as a guarantee, he had given us his Holy Spirit. So we are always confident, even though we know that as long as we live in these bodies, we are not at home with the Lord. That is why we live by believing and not by seeing. Yes, we are fully confident. And we would rather be away from these bodies for then we will be at home with the Lord. So our aim is to please

them always whether we are in this body or away from this body. For we must all stand for Christ to be judged. We will each receive whatever we deserve for the good or evil we have done in our body. It is because we know this solemn sphere of the Lord that we work so hard to persuade others. God knows we are sincere. And I hope you know this too.”

Here he is saying that all throughout life, you've grown in these damn bodies. And you know on Friday, I asked the people. I said everyone here that's not going through something raise the hands. If you're not going through something right now, some kind of trauma, something you're struggling with, something you deal with. I asked everybody in the room that's not going through something right now raise your hands. Not a single hand went up. Everybody is going . . . we've grown and we struggle in this life. We've grown and we struggle in these bodies. And the older we get the more we understand the clothes of these bodies are going to death. That's just the truth about it.

But you see when you understand about the green grass on the other side, that stuff doesn't bother you as much. And when you understand where you're going, you live life with a whole different zest than you do when you're so fatalistic about life. See people I understand I'm going to a place that's a hundred times better. But that's not really the message that I want to bring to you this morning. That's a preface to the message. 'coz I'm going to talk about an hour and 40 minutes. That's just the preface to the message. It's really not the message that I want to bring to you. Not about really the gloriousness of heaven. I want you to go get the book because we've bought a lot of them to put back in the bookroom for you to get because you need to read about the divine revelation of heaven.

You need to have an idea of where you're going. You know when you're going on vacation, when people tell you about it, it makes you want to go there. I had a man who just got back from one of the islands in the Virgin Islands. And when he came back, he was describing the hills and the beauty of how the water was, the sand, and the beaches, the nature trip. He made it seem sound so enticing, I said my next vacation that's where I want to go. So some of you need to read about heaven so you understand where your loved ones are and you understand where you are going. And it makes a whole world of difference when you have an idea of where you're going 'coz right now we think it's just church.

And you know if someone promised you that if you are good in this life, if you do right, I'll let you spend the rest of eternity in church. Do you know if that would motivate a whole lot of folks? I need you to be flat honest about it. Even a whole lot of people in this room right now, if you had to spend eternity sitting up in the arch of salvation listening to me, many of you say will look, I don't know about all of that. If you had to spend it in church for the rest of eternity, that wouldn't motivate a

whole lot of people. And that's why you need to know and you need to understand at least from another perspective. And I can't guarantee whether it's all true.

But I can tell you this. There's nothing that you can say too good about heaven. And there's nothing you can say too bad about hell. So whatever is in the book, it can't be too good. And whatever is in there about hell, it can't be too bad. And it has transformed a whole lot of people because it has given them a visual idea of what heaven is like and what hell is like. 'coz I mean even with the best preacher, nobody wants to sit and listen to him 24 x 7 for eternity. So we need to have an idea even before . . . that's really not the message that I want to bring you to this morning. I want you to turn your bibles to 2nd Peter Chapter 3.

And when you get there, I then want you to flip over to psalm the 90th chapter. 2nd Peter Chapter 3 and then also flip over to psalms and 90th chapter. And in those two verses that I primarily want to speak to you from today is when I speak about an hour and 40 minutes. And in 2nd Peter 3:3 and this is a verse that you've heard. Perhaps many times before. And it says this. "But beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing." He's saying to the people I want you to know this one thing. Look at your neighbor and look at him and tell him, I want you to know this one thing. He says well beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing. Now it was so important to him that he said be not ignorant.

So I want you all to know this one thing. And it's this one thing that I'm reeling my whole message on today. And it's the one thing that he didn't want you to be ignorant of. "But beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years and a thousand years as one day." Now flip over to psalms 90. You should have already had that bookmarked. And the 4th verse of the 90th chapter of psalms says for a thousand years in thy sight are but as yesterday when it has passed and as a watch in the night. Says here that a thousand years in God's sight is what is yesterday. Same thing fundamentally it says in 2nd Peter. A thousand years is but a day under God.

And again the 90th chapter of psalms, go down to the 10th verse. And the 10th verse reads thus. "The days of our years are 3 score years and 10. And if by reason of strength, they be forced those years and yet if their strength, labor, and sorrow, for it is soon cut off and we fly away." Let me read that same verse in the new living translation. 70 years are given to us. Some may even reach 80. But even the best of these years are filled with pain and struggle. Soon they disappear and we are gone. And though that verse is spoken thousands of years ago where it says 70 years are given to man. The average lifespan of the average man is still right around that 70 years.

And I took out my calculator. And I said now if a thousand years is under God as a day, then how long is 70 years. 70 years in God's eyes, 70 years in the eyes of an eternal lie, 70 years in

never ending times, counting a thousand years as but a day, 70 years is an hour and 40 minutes. And I speak to you today from the simple title. 1 hour and 40 minutes. People, that's all that most of us will have in this lifetime looking at it on an eternal scale. It's an hour and 40 minutes. Do you know even now most of the people that are over 40 years old? I'm 44 years old. Do you know the last 20 years went by like this? I understand if you said . . . to God a thousand years was like yesterday. It looked like the last since I graduated from college. And it has been 23 years ago. It looked like it was yesterday. How incredible! And the older you get the faster time speeds up. And it looked like it was yesterday. Time is flying by.

Yet on an eternal scale, all of 70 years is only an hour and 40 minutes. But some of them have this mentality. We have a mentality that I'm going to whoop it up. I'm going to whoop it up. I'm going to live it up. I'm going to roll it up. I'm going to shoot it up. I'm going to sex it up. I'm going to live it up. I'm going to gamble it up. I'm going to drink it up. We got the mentality that I'm going to have me a smack dab good time in this life and I'm going to enjoy this long, long life that I have. People, you got an hour and 40 minutes. And you see when you open your eyes and you start seeing that. And that's why Jesus said take no folks to this life. Now I'm beginning to understand. It's an hour and 40 minutes out of all of our eternity. And see, when you start seeing it in that perspective, it changes things.

And see if you look at 70 years or 80 years as such a long period of time, yeah, you may think that way but not when you start thinking of it in terms of an hour and 40 minutes. I've got an hour and 40 minutes and yet what I do in this hour and 40 minutes will determine where I spend the rest of my life. See we have got this impression that this is it, that this 70 years or this 80 years or this 60 years that we spend on this earth is it. No, no, no, no. That's an hour and 40 minutes. But yet this hour and 40 minutes will determine where you will be and what you will do for the rest of my life. This hour and 40 minutes determines what you will do for the rest of your life. This is not it people.

That's what Jesus was trying to get you to see the whole while. That's why Jesus was trying to get . . . see, we have even so geared and just focusing on this world and all the stuff we can get in 70 years. And you're going to leave every bit of it. And it's going to be quick. Ask any old person and they'll tell you child, I don't know where those years went. Ask anybody that's over 60 years old they'll tell you. It looked like I was just graduating out of high school just yesterday. The years are but a wafer because in the sight of all eternity, it's nothing but an hour and 40 minutes. But yet so many of us have got the mentality. I'm going to just enjoy myself. I'm going to live it up.

I've got another news bulletin for you. You're not going to fully live up that hour and 40 minutes. Because you see even that is an illusion because if you look at any of the things of the fleshly world, you only get a real kick from it when you first get in it. But it wears off. Look at anything in the fleshly world. Start with perhaps some of the most addicting stuff and some of the things that grab you the hardest.

Just look at the arena of drugs and just look at the heroin net. There's probably no greater rush than your first shot of heroin. So people that take it take them on a cloud 90. It puts them in a state of being that's like they've never felt before. A total feeling of euphoria. It's total bliss. They say it's something that's just out of this world and just puts them way up in heaven to them.

But the problem is they only get it one time. After that, it's a struggle and if you find anybody that's really wrapped up in the fleshly world, they're really not enjoying the stuff after they get over that initial hit. So the initial hit is great. But after the initial hit, so really . . . you really look at and find anybody that's addicted to anything of the flesh and you find they really don't get that much joy out of the thing. They have to keep doing the thing just to keep that where they used to be.

I mean just probably our 2 most common greatest addictive chemical stuff is perhaps cigarette and caffeine. And you all know plenty of people. They just absolutely cannot get started in the morning without their cups of coffee. They can't make it. But do you know if you put a person that is heavily addicted to caffeine. And people, caffeine is a narcotic for you all that don't know. Just a little bit of chemistry knowledge. It's an alkaloid. That's why caffeine ends in the same words as all of the rest of the addictive drugs. Caffeine, morphine, heroine, amphetamine. It's all alkaloids. That's why it's just as addictive. It's not just as harmful.

So people can't get started in the morning 'coz they're addicted to coffee. But if you take a person that doesn't drink coffee and you add a person that's addicted to it, do you think the person addicted to the coffee is any happier? Do you think their day goes any better than the person that doesn't drink? Take a person who smokes cigarettes. Another very strongly . . . nicotine. See that's a drug. That's why you don't . . . when you understand truth behind things you see some things. All of those alkaloid drugs, they work in virtually the same manner. They're just different strength and available in each one in different concentration. But they all work on the body just alike. They all work on the mind just alike. Take a person smoking cigarettes. Are they any happier than a person who doesn't smoke? No. But they can't make it without the cigarette.

And you see they think that it brings them joy and happiness but it really doesn't. It's the same way that all of the other stuff in the world. Somebody that's addicted on alcohol is the same. The alcoholic is no happier than the man who doesn't drink. As a matter of fact, if you go check the people that are addicted to the stuff are actually more miserable. But when it starts out, it gives them a rush. It gives them a feel of relief. But once they become addicted to it, they have to take the stuff just to try to get back to normal. So people, even if you think that you're going to spend your 70 years just in a high life, it really doesn't work like that.

Even women don't even work like that. Yeah, it's a thrill when you start out. It's a thrill when you got 4 or 5 women. You had 3 women and [unintelligible]. And after a while you got to have that just to maintain where you were before you got to that. So all that stuff is an illusion that will keep you happy. I know 'coz I live . . . it ain't . . . yeah, it's an illusion. There's no real truth and there's no real happiness. Wilt Chamberlain, a man who said he was with 20,000 women. I still can't figure out. How in the world? How in the world one man . . . I was trying to add it up. Even if you're 50 years old, how in the world you even get with 20,000 women. Even over 50 years. I can't even imagine that. So here is a man who had perhaps more women than any man ever. And I watched him on television. And he said all that stuff is empty. He said I would have traded it all just to have one woman that I really love. I would have traded it all.

So you see, it's really an illusion to even believe that just because we choose a certain life that is contrary to the style of God that we got real fulfillment. Because if you ever sit the person down, if you ever really get them to start pouring out their heart, you'll find out that it's empty. And they're trying to get all this stuff to fill an emptiness in his soul and for a minute it will work. But it won't hold up long. And then they'll need the stuff, just to try to have or get back to where they were before they started with the stuff. So it's an illusion. So people, an hour and 40 minutes will determine the rest of your life.

And yet if you had a man who had worked all his life, he had sacrificed and saved all his money. He didn't even buy a car. He rode the bus so he could save the money. He didn't even buy a house. He lived in a boarded home so he could save the money. He ate the cheapest food so he could save money. He saved all his money all his life. And he got to be 50 years old. And he saved all his money. And then he went out. And he spent everything he had for 30 minutes of pleasure. You'd say that man was a fool. But that's what we do. You say that man was a fool. Because we are risking the rest of our lives for an hour and 40 minutes. And it took my brother telling me that it was a hundred times better on the other side to change my view of life.

And I don't have a morbid view of life. I'm in no rush to die. I plan on living to be 120. But I even know and I even calculated it out on an eternal scale. Even if I lived to be a 120 years old, that's 2 hours and 53 minutes. I still have made it longer on a real long church service. It's 2 hours and 53 minutes if I live to be a 120 years old. You see that's why we got to understand some spiritual truths. And that's why Jesus was trying to get us . . . That's why Jesus told don't even store up treasure on earth 'coz Jesus knew you ain't going to be here but an hour and 40 minutes.

Now see if you were going to go somewhere and that's why when you understand things, some spiritual, you'll change the way you view things. And even in the

church, now we need such a focus. Only an hour and 40 minutes. And just the stuff that we can accumulate and think we can enjoy. 9 out of 10 times, we're focusing on trying to get more money, big cars, big house. Can't enjoy that stuff in the first place. So you got to worry about big old . . . folks got big old cars and now that gas is 2 dollars and something a gallon . . . so all that big old stuff is an hour and 40 minutes. And you see when you start doing it that way.

And even yesterday I was out. And I saw a homeless man on the street. And I said how do you do? I need to start building up my treasure in heaven a little more. And I saw . . . [unintelligible] it ain't going to be but an hour and 40 minutes. And I've used up half of that already. So I have maybe about 50 minutes left. So see when I started looking at it, it changed my whole life. I started looking at it like I got 80 years, I've got about 50 minutes left. And I need to make sure that I've got my treasure built up in heaven. And when I saw the man and he was there. And you see, God has to sometimes speak to us so we can . . .

See, I had seen the man. He's at the store where I shop a lot. And when I saw the man the first thing that ran through my spirit how come every time I come here this man is out here every time. And God spoke this to me. 'coz I said to myself I've given the man money plenty of times before. How come he's out here every time? And God spoke this. He said you need your money every pay period. You don't need money no one time. I mean that's why I said revelation hits you sometime. And I can tell when it was . . . [unintelligible] dark. I saw it in a different light. See before I had been seeing the man just beg or just out of his job. And you see he was in a condition where he could not get a job. Because I can look at him and you could tell nobody would really hire the man. He was old. He was decrepit. And the other thing about it he was dark skinned. Now some of y'all will think well, what difference does that make? You've never seen a light skinned black man out begging homeless. If you think about it you've never seen a light skinned man.

It puts more persecution on the darker skin. You all know I'm telling you the truth. And folks are going to say this but it's the absolute truth. And if you ever go out and look at all the homeless men on the street, you'll find that all of them are dark skinned. Because society puts more pressure lets you [unintelligible] in your life. That's just plain as day. So it became then part of my responsibility to help the man. I reached in my wallet and gave the man \$20. Because normally if I hadn't had that revelation and I just thought this yesterday, I'd have just given him a dollar. But I didn't point it out. I'd just taken that out of my heavenly bank account 'coz I told y'all about it.

See the Bible says when you give your arms, you give them in secret 'coz when you reveal it before me and you've already gotten your reward. So I just took it out of my heavenly bank account. I got to put some more in there. And I can't tell you all about it. But I began to have a whole different view of life. And the dream that the

young lady had was just as accurate. Because now I don't even view this life, people as not going. She was just as right as she could be. I'm just as happy as I can be 'coz I'm going to the Lord. Now I may not be going for another 80 years. But that ain't but an hour. Just little or no time. And you all know this time is planned.

You all know that like one year comes before you even know it. Time is ticking by so fast you don't know where the time went. It's flying. People you got an hour and 40 minutes in this life. And we are thinking this is the eternity. And we're limited like this is the eternity and it's not. And if a fool, just even as a businessman is a fool that will put all his investment in an hour and 40 minutes and he's got to live the rest of his life. That's a fool. So yes, even when you understand it, it is not even me being so spiritual. That's just common sense. If I'm only for an hour and 40 minutes and what I do in this hour and 40 minutes is going to determine where I'm going to spend the rest of my life, I would be a fool to mess up this hour and 40 minutes.

That's not even being that serious. But I'd be a fool once I realized and once I understood it an hour and 40 minutes. People, if you grab a hold net, if you grab a hold net, it will change your whole life. I'm getting ready to end this message. Not necessarily because I'm finished. But because I want the service today to end after an hour and 40 minutes. By 12.40, I want the service to be over. That's an hour and 40 minutes. That's all you have. That's all you have to determine where you're going to spend the rest of eternity. Don't mess it up. And don't even think that life is necessarily full of burdens. And you ain't got to bear it that long. You have an hour and 40 minutes. It may appear like it's a long time. But it's only an hour and 40 minutes. So I don't care if somebody is beating you over the head, somebody gets a little thank goodness, I ain't got to put up with you . . . but an hour and 40 minutes.

It's not but an hour and 40 minutes. Time is flying. And people, you need to understand it. You need to get the book A Divine Revelation Of Heaven. Now we don't have the one A Divine Revelation Of Hell here. But I'm going to get it. 'coz a whole lot of you need to read it. I at first wasn't going to read that. But I think I am. I wanted [unintelligible] 'coz I said I don't even want to know what's in hell. But I do need to know. 'coz I need to see whether that it's true or not. The people that have read the book, they are scared. So whether it's true or not, I need to know it. So I got an idea of the gruesome stuff that's there.

Brother, come on. Let's pray. We're going to be out of here at 12.40, an hour and 40 minutes. Now you know you came to me at 11'O clock. Church started at 11'O clock. [Music]. Anyone that wants to come to salvation, get up. Anybody that wants to come to salvation, come on now. Don't have as much time to think through. Just have an hour and 40 minutes. But you see Jesus comes . . . in the last minute. Don't know when it is. . Pray now. Open his eyes. Let him see us

with hands in the direction that he used to travel . . . let him understand that life is short, that had its struggle, that had its trial, that had its tribulation.

Let this hour and 40 minutes change the rest of our lives.
