

Due Season

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Nathaniel Bronner: Welcome to Brothers of the Word because brother you need the word. And if there had been some things in your life that you had been waiting on and yet has not appeared, I want you to stay tuned to this message upon today. We are going to be studying from the Book of Galatians, the 6th Chapter and the 9th Verse, and it reads thus, "And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not." "And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season" -- you all say due season.

All: Due season.

Nathaniel Bronner: We shall reap, if we faint not." And I am going to be talking to you today for a few minutes from that simple subject of "Due Season," for in due season. And I want you to understand that all of the promises of God are -- they're all based on conditions, and here he says, "Don't be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap," but it didn't guarantee you are going to reap. It's an if-then clause. It didn't just say you're just going to reap the promises in due season. There is a clause that goes with it. It says, "if" -- you all say, "if".

All: If.

Nathaniel Bronner: That is a small word with an extremely large meaning because there are so many things in your life that's predicated on the word 'if'. If you do something, then and hear the word of God says, "If we faint not, in due season we shall reap." And I am here today to tell you about due season. That we have sometimes wondering, you know, when is going to be -- when will it be my time? When will -- when will this thing that I have been working on, that I've been praying for, that I've been dreaming of, when will this thing come out? I'll tell when it's going to come. It's going to come in due season. But you need to understand some things about due season.

Also, in that Book of Galatians and the true verses prior to what we just read in Galatians, Chapter 6, Verses 7 and 8. It says this, "Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever," -- say whatsoever.

All: Whatsoever.

Nathaniel Bronner: Do you know whatsoever means everything? It means all that the subject says, "For whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap everlasting life." And so, God has not made a fool of. So, whatever you sow good or bad, whatever you sow shall be reap. When? In due season.

In Leviticus 26:4, it says, "Then I will give you rain in due season, and the land shall yield her increase, and the trees of the field shall yield their fruit." And when you read Leviticus 26:4, you'll find that all that is predicated on some prior verses, and the prior verses simply say this on a nutshell, "If you do what I say, then in due season, I'll send the rain and it will produce the crops and all the promises that I have made unto you." And I just want -- I want to just outline for you, seven keys to your due season.

And the first thing about due season is, number one, you have to have the right ground, right ground. If you're ever going to have a right harvest, you must first begin with right ground. Do you know when a man plants a seed into a woman, that's the ground? That's why when a woman is going through her ovulation cycle; it's called her fertile period. And the seed is implanted in the woman. And do you know what you will produce depends on what kind of ground you're seed has planted in? You must have the right ground.

Men, let me give you a good -- if it goes with all the single men, just raise your hand. To feel -- let me give you a good judgment of how to judge a future wife. Ask yourself one simple question or two questions. First, ask the question, would I want to take her home to mama? That's first question. Then, if you don't want to take her home to mama, that's not her.

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Second question that you need to ask is this. Would I want this woman to be the mother of my children? And when you cut through those two things, in other words, is this a good ground for me to put my seed and, if you have a problem, but I want one of those. You need to go the other dress. You must have a right ground. And anytime you are going to have a harvest, you need to always analyze the ground of where you're going to put your

seed. If it something in business, what am I investing in? You must have a right ground. Even in education, what am I going to get in education, what kind of ground am I going to put all of my time in to that it will produce the harvest that I am looking for? You can't put good seed on stony, rocky, sandy soil because it will not produce proper fruit. Choice of ground is the first part of bringing forth your due season.

Second thing you have to have is the right time. Proverbs 24, 20 and verse 4 says this, "The sluggard will not plow by reason of the cold. Therefore, he shall beg in harvest and have nothing." You have to have right time. It doesn't do you any good to plant the right seed in the right ground at the wrong time. There are seasons and timings on things. Even if you are a farmer, you cannot go planting a watermelon seed into the other one, not in time for it. You have to know when to plant the right seed in the right ground. There are some things in our life, people, where you got to know timing and, when you plant the seed and when you plant in the right ground, you must understand that it's going to take some time for the thing to manifest, and the right time you must know even what you are doing right now.

Sometimes, we get the stories because we don't see the fruit right away. God is concerned about what you are doing in your right time in the right ground with the right seed right now. And you have to do this job right now. Because what you do today determines what you're going to get tomorrow. Sometimes, people got some stuff right. You see, some of the stuff you got right now, you're start putting that stuff into place long time ago. When you start feeling some aches in your body, that was the consequence of what you did this morning. Now sometimes, it can. I am talking about when it went down in the joints, you know. That's some stuff has gone up a lot. That's some stuff away. It is a result of some harvest that some things you barely doing.

So, what you do today will influence, and that's the difference between visionary people. Most people can only see some stuff right now. They can only see stuff for the day. Visionary to see the stuff of what is going to be 5, 10, 15, 20 years down the road, and they'll start doing some stuff, putting some things into place, putting some patterns and some procedures and doing stuff that is going to make a difference way down the road.

That's why most people don't ever save anything because they live for the moment.

One good way to tell how visionary a person is to look at the savings. Most people spend up every dime they get today, hoping they'll make some more tomorrow and not understanding we got to put some seal right now for some things. And you just need to, first of all, know what to do when the right time of right now with the seed that God has granted you. Because, oftentimes, you're not even be able to see the full multiplicity of the thing that God is going to do in your life. There are so many things we have prophesied free to sitting in the back and, at her last convention, she prophesied, she says -- she said, "Just stand up and just start rejoicing for the new building." I said, "What new building?" Have brother Rick. They said the prophet had called him and said, "The church that you are attending, so that church is going out, it's going to be the building multiple times its size of where it is." Now, the problem with that is this. We haven't feel that he's building it. Just take the camera and just hand them out over the crowd. Just turn the cameras.

Ms. Panama just take a look at the crowd. This building does not fit and this is just the downstairs. So, you got the upstairs and the upstairs, there is not many people there, and the downstairs is not full and yet God will say, "Start preparing and you are going to have more folk. You're going to need a building. This is going to be multiple times in size," and the problem is this one. It didn't feel up here. That's not my problem. Turn to the person next to you and say, "That's not the pastor's problem."

All: That's not the pastor's problem.

Nathaniel Bronner: Do you know the pastor's problem is? The pastor's problem is doing what God has told him to do right now. You see, the increase is not my problem. My problem is doing what God has instructed me to do right now.

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And God has spoken unto me a couple of weeks ago and he said, "I want you to increase the capacity of your web service for the websites six-fold." And I told James then. And we don't -- we've got major traffic, but the servers we have, there is plenty to

build. He said increase to six-fold. AirJesus.com is down right now working on time. If we're to down, what he said when he said it wouldn't be down right now? So, there are some things that you can't even see, and I don't know why he said. I don't know why he said do this, and I had to go back and pray after I heard the second prophecy about it, new building. And I said, "Lord, what in the world -- what kind of a new building?" He said, "When you have to build the new building, you'll build it to handle six times the capacity of this building just like the website." Now, the issue with this building will hold configure property and jam packed 700 people. Six times, that is 4,200 people. That's a 20 million dollar building all day long.

Now, this is the thing about due season. You just do what God has told you to do. The 20 million dollar, that's his problem. But how that's going to come about? Just do what God has told you to do. So, when it gets to the point, you see things that God has spoken into your life, you'll just do what God has told you to do and you worry about letting God bring the increase all you're responsible for, all you can do is what he had instructed you to do and that's all I can do. But if I do that, that's all I need to do.

Sometimes, we tried to worry about handling what God is supposed to do. We're not half doomed, and we're trying to worry about what other folk. You handle your job. By the time you handle your job, that's about all -- I'm not worry about the president's job. That's why you don't hear me talking about the pre -- I've got -- I've got all I can do handling what I am supposed to do. I don't have time to run the United States government because that's not my job, that's not my response. I have enough issue just worrying what I am supposed to do. And by the time I can look myself in the mirror and said, "Boy, you have done a good job handling what you're supposed to do." That's all I can handle. You know, I'm about to poop down and following that, and you'll find that when you do your job well, you'll have less time to talk about other folk and their job because, sometimes, we talked about other folk, what a star job they're doing to cover what they say. We're not doing I was looking who. So, you just do what you are supposed to do to the best of your ability in the right time, and that right time is right now.

First thing you need is this, you have to have a right seed and just as I told the man that you have to look at a woman and ask

yourself, would I want this woman to be the mother of my children? You have to have the right seed and see the woman as the ground. The man provides the seeds, and lady you have to do the same thing. You have to look for a man and ask yourself, would I want this man to be the father of my children? And if you don't want him to be the father of your children, don't pull with it. Don't even go out with him. Don't waste time chatting on the phone with him because it get messed up sleeping -- if you can look at this man as, "No, I don't want this man be the dad of my child. I just -- that ain't my baby daddy. Now look, if you don't want this man to be the father of your child, don't even pull it with you because they'll succeed, and you have to have a right seed because if you see -- and sometimes, you cannot tell the difference between a seed of corn and a weed. Because, you know, weed has seeds. How do you think weeds grow? They grow by seeds.

So, if you don't know the difference of it, you cannot discern between the types of seed. You'll end up with the wrong type of harvest. You must be able to have right seed, and where did you get the seed from? Do you know where you get the seed from? Fruit. Fruit for those who see. That's why God says, "If you shall be its fruit for every fruit that has within it a seed." You get seed from fruit. So, if you want to know what kind of seed, look at the fruit. They'll tell you. If you want to know what kind of a seed is it, look at the fruit. All seed comes from fruit. So, if you want to know what kind of seed is this, look at the fruit of their lives and it will tell you exactly what kind of seed it is. Now, listen to what they said, look at the fruit.

So, another thing my dad used to say. He said, "I don't judge people. The Bible says you should know them by their fruits." He said, "I'm just a food inspector." So, just look at the fruit and the fruit. Don't worry about the next thing to what they say. Just look at the fruit. That's all you're going to do. Look at the fruit. Look at the fruit.

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And you'll send yourself the kind of fruit that I want in my life. I want apples. I want oranges. I want peaches. I want plums. I want pears. And you look in and you'll see (00:15:12) and thorns and weeds and bramble bushes. Don't listen to what they -- because weeds are smooth. They've always been smooth

talks, the fruit. So ladies, before you go and set the seed, look at the fruit because fruit reproduces after its own time. Have the right seed.

Four things you must do is this, you must plant the seed. Now the issue with planting seed is you must always break ground to plant seed. Ground is often us. And that's why the Bible -- it says over Jeremiah 4:3 says, "For thus saith the Lord to the men of Judah and Jerusalem, Break up your fallow ground, and sow not among thorns." To plant the seed, you must break the ground. The problem with breaking ground is nearly painful. Anytime we have to break something, it's painful. To start a crack to yield a harvest, you have to break some old habits, and it's tough and it's difficult, and most of the time, we don't want to do it. And when something breaks, it hurts. We often cry, hurler everything else, but if you ever going to plant a seed, you have to break the fallow ground, which is often hard and hard.

And people, you can never plant anything in anyone's lives until you first break through the ground. That's why they called it simple hardheaded. What that mean is you can't break through the ground. They got hardheaded. Do you know you can get anything at a hardheaded person's head? You can break the ground. I don't care what kind of wisdom you have. If you can't break the ground, you can't get it in the head. And if you can't get it in the head, you can never produce harvest. I don't care what kind of seeds you have. You can have seeds to every great food in the world, and if it sits here on this pulpit, it will never produce. You got to put that stuff in the ground, and you have to be able to break the ground to get it in there. And if you can't break the ground, you'll never be able to get the seed into where it can produce food.

Fifth thing you need is this, you will need patience. You all say, "Have patience."

All: Have patience.

Nathaniel Bronner: You've got to have patience. What happens when we break the ground and plant the seed and we make some changes, we want our oak tree overnight. We want a magical Jack and the beanstalk. We want to think they shoot up overnight. Whatever you put seed in the ground, first of all, it must reside in darkness. You can't see it growing. You cannot

see it germinating. There are some things going right now, going out in the spirit world and some things happening in some of your life. They are bringing your due season, but the problem is you can't see it. If we are going to need a new building, I can't see where in the world that's come. I have no idea. What in the world are we going to need a building that big for?

First of all, we have been here in this building for 10 years, and we're still not full yet. So, if we've been here for 10 years and I am realistic about my life span, you know, because even if I live to be a hunk, I am going to stop preaching at least about 80. So, I don't have much long. So, the question is if we've been here this long and we haven't filled it, how are we going to need something more? I cannot see what is going on under the ground. I cannot see what my eyes cannot invent. I don't know what's happening out of the spirit now and it's that way in your life. All I know is I need to do what God has told me to do and let that lead that up to Him what's going on.

You see, number one, with all of our scientific knowledge, all of the best biologist in the world, they cannot really tell you what makes the seed germinating growth. Now, they can break it down typically. They can tell you about the DNA, the deoxyribonucleic acid. They can tell you about the mitochondria. They can tell you about the chromosomes. They can tell you about all of that, but when it boils down bottomline, they cannot tell you really what makes the seed grow. They cannot tell you that if you take a seed, put that seed and irradiate it or boil it and bring it back. Nothing will happen to it. Same typical composition, but something has killed the life in. There is a force of light that Science cannot understand nor explain. There was a part of your due season that is supernatural that man cannot understand.

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But there is a part that man can understand. Man does have sense enough to know this. You got to get some good ground, have some good seed, break the ground, stick the seed in, covered it up, and wait. Now, the man does have that much sense, you see, and this is where we get our track. We don't do the stuff when we do have sense enough to understand. You see, we're trying to look for the 'the' stuff. I wonder what -- you know, I wonder will the chromosomes split? I wonder really

what is happening on the subatomic level. Look, stick it up on to the ground, cut it off, watering, and waiting. You see, we don't understand and we're not doing the stuff that we know.

James and I went to a seminar once, and they were discussing all these 'the' stuff. They were talking about the airplanes overhead and how -- sometimes, when you see this white vapor trails, how that was chemtrailed and how that was poisoning the atmosphere, and this was so dangerous some more. And it was hard as deep heavy duty governmental conspiracy stuff, and they were talking all these stuff. We need to fight the chemtrails in the air and all of the invisible radiation has come. And we noticed that when they had a break and we went outside and there has some folks outside smoking cigarettes, and when I looked at the gentleman and said, "What in the world?" They are sitting here worried about some potential possibility of some chemtrail up in the sky smoking a cigarette and they know that at least 200 identified with carcinogen is killing them direct. Don't worry about the stuff way up there that you have no -- because you have the stuff you can't control. Stick that seed in the ground. You see, you do have sense enough to get you some good seed and some good ground, break up the ground, stick it in, cover it up, and you just do the stuff you know what to do.

You see, that's the part of due season. You see, every time we get in the stuff and while we have not done that in due season when you trace that stuff there, you haven't done some stuff that you mean to do, not only supernatural, not even with the angels and the battle between Lucifer. And look, I am talking about some stuff you know what to do. So, when we do that, we handle the part of the farmer of planting and reap it. Then, our harvest do beyond over (00:22:28) thing that you need to do is this. You have to protect the seed. The minute you plant, forces in nature start marshaling to destroy your harvest. In nature, they are called pests. That's what the soils of locus were all about. Weeds will grow up. All kinds of things will come to try to end up and destroy and to block your harvest. You have to protect your harvest just because you come down here and get save, that's just the beginning of the battle. You have to protect your harvest every single day. Just because you get some money, that's just the beginning of your battle. Do you know as what folk wake up every morning is to figure out how to get your money? Do every time when you leave this church and you drive

by billboards you know the prime purpose of billboards? Get your money.

So, you have one person, which is you thinking how to get some money and you have thousands upon thousands that every person will see two thousand ads in one form or another every day. All of the ads have one purpose in mind, get your money. Everything will be targeted to get to soak up and destroy and to take your seed. You have to protect your seed in whatever form it is. The devil will send down in to destroy your seed. They'll send discouragement in to destroy your seed. He will send lack of discipline in to destroy your seed. He'll send rebellion in to destroy your seed. He'll send all kind of stuff to destroy your seed so that you'll never get your harvest in due season.

The seventh thing is this. You got to pick the fruit. Do you know picking fruit is a hard job? Sometimes, even when the door is open and even when the harvest does come, even when the opportunities, you got to go and pick the fruit because, oftentimes, the fruit just uncut even on the tree. Sometimes, you have to get a ladder. You have to crawl up to get here. You have a thing that will shake the tree. You have to -- do you know cod picking was hard? Even when you got the harvest, it was a hard job to get the harvest over the tree, to go and get the grapes off of the vine. You have to pick the harvest and some, you see, harvest often times will come and it will be simply an opportunity. They watched you go and pick the opportunity. There comes your reward, but you have to go and pick it from the tree. Often times, we want God to just go get it off the tree, put in the plate, cook it everything, and bring it on to us.

God is telling some of you today its due season. Do all that you can do and, you see, there is a part that God has to do. He controls the wind and the sun and the rain. That's why he said, he will send the rain. You see, man can't control the rain as Gods. Sometimes, God does give man control of it. It's called irrigation. So, if you have a really need a bath, I can build a well. He'll tell you, you build a well and you bring the water in. Well, he'll give you the knowledge and give you the provisions and the ability to do it. He wants to let you know today that for so many of you, its due season, but you have to go through the process of a farmer to make sure that your crop comes in.

Turn to the person and just asked him, is it your time? And you need to understand some things about God's due season, and there is something that I want you to know about due season. I said, you can't be happy here. You're not harmed. I guess, I can't wait to get out of here. I said, "Don't you understand?" I said, "Man, all you got to do now is go to the cafeteria, give them your meal card and eat." Don't you understand, but the majority of people even in paradise were not happy and some of you will say, "Well, once I can leave this earth and get to heaven," let me tell you something. A third of angels in heaven would cast out when they found stuff wrong and handed to them. So, even if you go to heaven with a nasty attitude and on the prison, you're just

bullied out of that. Even the third of the angels, they weren't satisfied in heaven itself. So, you need to learn even though due season is coming and, people, let me tell you something. There is some 'K' marked or whatever. You haven't been naked. So, you have been clothed, and we have been well fed. Turn to the person sitting next to you, well fed.

All: Well fed.

Nathaniel Bronner: You know, you may not be eating right and you may not be eating nutritious, but you got some stuff in you that you ain't hungry. We have been well fed. So, you need to understand about due season. Don't get hang up on the future because unless you get your attitude right about the pressed. Don't get hang up at Lord when I -- if I can just get married. Then, you get mad from my Lord if just get rid of them. You know, don't get hang up. Lord, if I just get the promotion. Lord, if I just get a new car, if I can just get a new house. Lord, if I could just get this and that and the other, then I'll be happy. No, you will not.

And the same people that I went to college with whom we are complaining about college, same people, man this corporate world like to beat me to dead. I wish I was back in college. I

said, "If I could tell you. I tried to tell you." So people, I'm trying to tell you now. Learn to enjoy where you are and learn how to enjoy what you have right now, and you will get that master. That's why when you read about what happens to the people who win the lottery, most of men are getting it. Why? Because they're thinking that once they get it, this is all going to solve and you've never learn how to be appreciative of all. Because people, I can tell you some of you already have, you have an abundance of stuff. You have way beyond and you haven't learned how to appreciate that what you have, and you don't appreciate some stuff. When you read all of those prayer requests, I got to read all of them. Oh, you just don't appreciate some stuff.

When you learn how to appreciate what you have, where you are, God will take you to another level. Because you don't -- you don't want to give someone something they don't appreciate what you had already given. Supposed you gave someone 10 dollars and they said, 'huh'. Would you want to give them a 100? And that's why some of you can get more because you don't appreciate what you already got. And not only -- not only will you not get more when you are unappreciative, you will lose that what you have. You will lose it. It will be snatched away from you because of vibrations.

So, due season is coming, and there is some great things in store for so many of us but, people, I'm here to take it first. I'm here to tell you my due season is right now. But I just -- something just led me to just call the three of you out and just speak a word unto you. Because for the three of you that there is a due season that's very, very close, and God just wants to speak a word unto you.

And young man -- and I can see in the spirit just a -- there's a load on your back. Now, some things are -- what's called a generic, because if I called a hundred folk of men, then I will have a load on your back. But I just see a load on your back, and it has been bending you somewhat. But I see in the spirit just a load dropping off, and I see just straightening up. And God is just speaking to you, it's your time. But this is also what I see. I see you picking back up the load because you are going to carry some things for some others and there's going to come a light of understanding when you will understand that the Lord is not a bad thing, and you will understand that to carry the load, it is better to have a strong back than a light load. God says, I'm going to strengthen you, and some in my Kingdom, they are designed for strength, but I don't give strength for no reason.

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I give strength so that thou may carry the load, and you're going to be a leader in your arena, and leaders always have to carry loads. That was a message of Jesus that he changed the bad, our burdens. And we all said we want to be like Jesus, one will carry about a load because I'm going to strengthen you, and I'll take the load off, but you will pick it back up because you have understanding. It is your time. Amen. Amen. Amen. Amen. Amen. Amen. That makes some sense to you.

So sometimes, you have to go through a cold winter, but winter will kill off mosquitoes and fleas and all kind of pests on peas to spread disease. It's a new season. It's a new season. Amen. Amen.
