And now for The Plagues of Egypt Part 14, The Other Locusts.

Nathaniel Bronner: Welcome to Brothers of The Word, because brother you need the word. And as you know, I have been for the past few months on a series entitled the Plagues of Egypt. And right now, we're in the middle of not just a plague that was in Egypt, but literally plagues here on the earth. If you would, go ahead AV department and play the first video for today.

Male: The Lord said to Moses go into Pharaoh for I have hardened his heart and the heart of his servants, that I may show these my signs among them and that you may tell in the hearing of your son and of your son's son, what things I have done to Egypt and my signs which I have done among them that you may know that I am the Lord.

Moses and Aaron went into Pharaoh and said to him, "This is what the Lord the god of the Hebrews says. How long will you refuse to humble yourself before me? Let my people go that they may serve me or else if you refuse to let my people go, behold tomorrow, I will bring locusts into your country and they shall cover the surface of the Earth. So that one won't be able to see the Earth. They shall eat the residue of that which has escaped which remains to you from the hail and shall eat every tree, which grows for you out of the field. Your houses shall be filled and the houses of all your servants, and the houses of all the Egyptians as neither your father's nor your father's fathers have seen since the day that they were on the earth to this day."

He turned and went out from Pharaoh. Pharaoh's servant said to him, "How long will this man be a snare to us? Let the men go that they may serve the Lord their God, don't you get know that Egypt is destroyed?" Moses and Aaron were brought again to Pharaoh and he said to them, "Go, serve the Lord your God, but

who are those who will go. Moses said, “We will go with our young and with our old, with our sons, and with our daughters, with our flocks, and with our herds will we go for we must hold a feast to the Lord.” He said to them, “The Lord be with you if I let you go with your little ones. See, evil is clearly before your faces, not so. Go now, you who are men and serve the Lord for that is what you desire.”

They were driven out from Pharaoh’s presence. The Lord said to Moses, “Stretch out your hand over the Land of Egypt for the locusts that they may come up on the Land of Egypt and eat every herb of the land even all that the hail has left.”

Moses stretched out his Rod over the Land of Egypt in the Lord brought an East Wind on the land all that day and all night. And when it was morning, the East Wind brought the locusts. The locusts went up over all the land of Egypt and rested and all the borders of Egypt. They were very Grievous. Before them, there were no such locusts as they, nor will there ever be again. Where they covered the surface of the whole earth so that the land was darkened and they ate every herb of the land and all the fruit of the trees which the hail had left.

There remain, nothing green either tree or herb of the field through all the land of Egypt. Then Pharaoh called for Moses and Aaron in haste, and he said, “I have sinned against the Lord your God and against you. Now therefore, please forgive my sin again and pray to the Lord your God that he may also take away from me this death.”

He went out from Pharaoh and prayed to the Lord, the Lord turned an exceeding strong west wind which took up the locusts and drove them into the Red Sea. There remained not one locust in all the borders of Egypt, but the Lord hardened Pharaoh’s heart and he didn’t let the children of Israel go.

Nathaniel Bronner: Now this is the plague of locusts and the title of today’s message is simply the Plagues of Egypt the other locusts. What most people don’t know because our news here in America has primarily concentrated on the current viral plague that we’re dealing with right now. If you watch the news, that’s just about all it’s on the news. It dominates the news day in, day out. All

you know about is the virus that's plaguing the whole Earth, but what folk don't know is it right now and for the last few months, there has been a serious plague of locusts that sweeping over the African continent.

It's sweeping over about eight or nine countries right now and the locust plague has become so bad they're expecting a second wave of locusts to come at him at about another month and they said this plague of locusts is going to be about 20 times what the current one is.

So right now, the world is facing literally a plague of locusts and it is advancing right now where the very country that we're dealing with now, the plagues of Egypt, the Locust are advancing on Egypt as we speak right now.

So, when God says preach about the plagues of locusts, he knew when he talked about the plagues of Egypt is all this stuff was coming. AV Department, I want you to just play the second video and you get just a glimpse of what's going on right now across the world.

Female: So, we're fighting a coronavirus pandemic, but what about the swarms?

Male: An enemy far more lethal than any human force.

Female: Even in that Hollywood movies, bugs make our skin fall. But when they're real, and there's a COVID-19 pandemic, that's a huge problem that just go worse. And right now, the UN says swarms some as big as a city are eating their way through Pakistan and Africa.

So, can we stop this plague of locusts or will the coronavirus ruin any chance of getting these swarms under control?

So, while we've been stuck inside because of the coronavirus, outside there's been a plague of locusts. Locusts are like grasshoppers on steroids. Under the right conditions, some of these members of the grasshopper family morph into locusts.

This plague is threatening the crops and livelihoods of tens of millions of people. Kenya hasn't had it this bad in 70 years. Ethiopia and Somalia haven't seen anything like it in 25. Locusts

are also in Eritrea, Uganda and South Sudan. The threat dates back to 2018 when wet weather led to a population this big. And with the rainy season, the UN says the number of locusts could increase by 20 times.

Male: If you imagine that the one square kilometer were 50 million individuals, then you can calculate how many there are. You've got billions and billions of locusts.

Female: And the timing is horrible. Their arrival in the horn of Africa coincides with the main planting season.

Male: Clear to drop.

Female: In South Sudan, even before the locusts invaded, 5.3 million people couldn't get enough to eat. A peace deal has raised the prospect of more farmers planting this season, but now --

Male: This is the perfect time for the swarms to destroy all the crop or plants. Unless we take measures, the food accurately in a situation of the next coming scenario will be the worst.

Female: So, what's behind the swarm? Why now?

Nathaniel Bronner: All right, you can cut the video now. But that's just a little bit of what's happening right now in a lot of the countries in Africa and the thing about it, it's just like this virus started in another country and the virus hopped from that country to another country to another country until they literally has infested the entire world. The locusts have the same potential, because now with travel, locusts hop aboard the other stuff. They hop aboard freight liners and ships and airplanes, and all it takes is one pregnant locust to get in your land, and before you know it, one pregnant locust, and then, wet weather and now you've got a locust plague here in the United States.

And locust have been here and plagued the US just not in our lifetime, but you see, we haven't seen anything like this in our lifetime either. The stuff is not new, we just haven't seen it. There have been plagues of locusts that have hit the US that have devastated the crops just not in our lifetime.

So, the plague of locusts is now going through Africa is devastating Africa and it's taking away the food that the people have to eat. So, you're going to have more people more than likely who will die from starvation because the locusts have eaten all of the food than people who have died from this virus.

So, you have to ask yourself. Why? Why? Why? And then, not only of the Africans facing locusts, they are facing the virus. And that's one reason what's making it so difficult to even fight the locusts because they've got the quarantines and the stay-at-home order and see that's kind of the way some of us are dealing with you. Most of us are not sick with the virus, but we're dealing with some other stuff that we're facing, just gotten worse because of it is making that stuff worse. So, we're not facing sickness from the virus, but we're facing other stuff and we got all these plagues and we got all this stuff and all of this stuff that's hitting us at one point. And the locusts are really, really rough.

The locusts won't hurt the people, they just devour all your stuff and sometimes when there are things that are sent against us, they don't hurt us, but they do devour all of our stuff. And the locusts are just rough. And God talked about in His blessings and curses and probably the most famous chapter of Deuteronomy, which is the 28 Chapter of Deuteronomy, that first verse begins, "Now it shall come to pass if you diligently obey the voice of the Lord your God, to observe carefully all his Commandments, which I command you to date, that the Lord your God will set you high above all nations of the earth and all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you because you obey the voice of the Lord your God."

This is how he begins at famous 28 chapter of Deuteronomy, and he begins talking about what's going to happen to you if you do what God says and the blessings that will come. He said, you'll be blessed in the city, you'll be blessed in the country, everything. You'll be blessed when you go in. He goes on for the next 13 verses from Deuteronomy 28:2 to 28:14, he goes on talking about how you're going to be blessed. Isn't that wonderful? That's just wonderful.

Then it gets to Deuteronomy 28:15. When he gets to do the Deuteronomy 28:15, he says, "But it shall come to pass." Starts out the same way. "If you do not obey the voice of the Lord your God, to observe carefully all his Commandments and his statues

which I command you today, that all these curses will come upon you and overtake you.” That’s Deuteronomy the 15th verse.

In the 16th verse, he begins to enumerate and outline all of the curses it come, but he then goes on for 13 verses like he did with the blessings. He goes on for 53 verses.

So, the curses cover 53 verses. The blessings cover 13 verses. Almost four times as many curses that God enumerate as he did blessings. And you said, why so many curses, versus, blessings? Sometimes, you don’t need but one good blessing. Sometimes, all you need is just one good bless. I’m sitting out here looking at this first row. I’m looking at Minister Stephanie, which is Pastor James’ wife and all of their children. See that one wife, sometimes you don’t need but one good blessing.

One good blessing can set you straight. And see one good blessing produces a whole lot of other blessings, but one bad curse produces a whole lot of other bad stuff that goes along with it.

So here, God didn’t -- he didn’t have to take the time to talk about and enumerating and elaborate on all of the blessings, but he did take the time to talk about and elaborate all them curses. And even in the 38th verse, he gets to the locusts.

Deuteronomy 28:38 says, “You shall carry much seed out to the field but gather little, for the locust shall consume it.” And then he goes on, “You shall plant vineyards and tend them but you shall not have a drink of the wine or gather the grapes for the worms shall eat them. You shall have olive trees throughout all your territory, but you shall not anoint yourself with the oil for your olives shall drop off. You should beget sons and daughters, but they shall not be yours for they shall go into captivity. Locusts shall consume all your trees and the produce of your land. The alien who is among you shall rise higher and higher above you and you shall come down lower and lower. He shall lender you, but you shall not lend to him. He shall be the head and you shall be the tail.”

This what happens when you don’t obey the voice of the Lord your God. If we just learn to listen, we will be shielded from the locusts and our stuff won’t get eaten up and devoured. And sometimes

it's a negative thing to talk about, but like I said, when he told me to preach about the Plagues of Egypt, that just wasn't a whole lot of good stuff. The good stuff comes in the fact that you see what happens and you don't go down that path.

The good stuff comes when you watch folk who disobeyed God and see what's happening to them, you don't disobey God. So, that's the good stuff that comes out of this. So, God here tells you if you listen to me, if you follow my word, if you do what I say, all these blessings will come on you. If you don't listen to me, if you don't follow all these curses and one of those curses, the locust shall devour all of your stuff.

But Pastor, you said the title of this message is the other locust. What are the other locusts? Now when you're surrounded -- did you all see how the swarms of locusts worth -- when the swarms of locusts come and they literally -- they're so heavy. They darken the skies. So, it's so many locusts and you go on the internet and search on the locust plate, you see people walking and it's just like in the middle -- it's just all of these swarms of flying grasshoppers are just everywhere, and the people have gotten used to because it doesn't help to brush him off. Brushing off just does no good at all because the minute you brush one off, they climb back on you again.

So, you just get countered -- just walking, there's a whole cloud of nothing but flying grasshoppers, nothing but locust. But Pastor, what do you mean by the other locust?

Now, here when God told Moses, he says, "Look, they're going to eat up everything green in the land." And this is the one place where it indicates there's not a whole lot of time between the place. I've talked about it in some of the other messages, we don't know how much gap was between the plagues, and this one, it probably was not that long because God says they're going eat up everything the hail left. That was from the last summer when all hail breaks loose.

So, have you ever had a situation when stuff done messed up your stuff and you don't even have a whole lot of stuff left and then I'm coming in, messed up that little stuff that you had left? That's basically what God says. He says the stuff that the hail left, the locusts are going to come and eat that little bit up.

So, that would be nothing green left in the land. And this means that the livestock that were left, it means they would have nothing to eat because they would normally eat the grass and -- the locusts are just going to clean everything out. So here, the people were faced just as they are in Africa right now. Here, they are faced with the potential of starvation.

So, you're looking all around you and you're looking at the locusts just eating up all of your crop, all of your food, all of your groceries, you're looking at all this stuff going to be devoured. Pastor, what do you mean by the other locusts? And in the middle of all of this, what in the world can you see good in the middle of all this? See, this is why I want to talk about the other locust because they're always going to be stuff wrong in the world and you will have to have the ability to see opportunity, to see beauty, to see the blessing in the middle of sometimes what the world will consider to be disaster.

So, what were the other locusts? Now, imagine yourself and I know some of us can't stand bugs, you know, any kind of bug just completely freaks a totally out. So, can you imagine you're standing in you got in the middle of literally billions of bugs and you're standing in the middle of these billions of bugs, you're about to starve because now all of these swarms of locusts will eat up all of your food.

So, how do you stand in the middle of all of this mess, all of this disaster, all of this destruction? How do you stand in the middle of that and see some good? Let me tell you about the other locust. In John, Chapter 3, as it begins in that first verse, "In those days, John the Baptist came preaching in the Desert of Judea and saying repent for the Kingdom of Heaven is near this is he who was spoken of through the prophet Isaiah. A voice of one calling in the desert prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for him." And actually, these locusts are called. They're really nicknamed desert Locust because they came out of the desert.

John's clothes were made of camel's hair and he had a leather belt around his waist. His food was locust and wild honey. His food was locust and wild honey. Now here imagine, when you watch that video all the way through, all you're going to hear of a locust and how they're eating up the food and how the folks are going to starve.

And here in this fourth verse of the third chapter of the Book of John, the Bible says John -- and Jesus said of John, there's been no one as great as him to walk the earth. And here John, out with clothing of camel's hair with a leather belt, but his food was locust and honey. And some of the real sophisticated Christians try to make it like, you know, that was a bean, because there's a bean called a locust bean.

When you go back and look at the original Hebrew and the original Greek, now, that was a dried insect. That was not a bean. That was a dried insect. Because sometimes you know, we just can't imagine, you know, John after eating locusts. I just can't imagine -- there are some things that we just can't even imagine then, but no that was the real locust. That was the grasshopper locust. That was not a bean. If you go back and you steady it and you look at the wording of it, that was a bug. That was an insect that John was eating.

Now, it was sweet because he may have been dipping it in honey, but this the point. You're in the middle, even though you got all of this disaster, that's food, but it depends upon how you look at it and see different people will see totally opposite things in the middle of the same situation.

Most of the people are going to see what the folk tell them to see and if you're told to see this is going to destroy all of your stuff. This is going to eat up all the crops and it's going to take all the food here. That's true, but it is not truth. The truth is yes, they are going to eat all of that because the average locust would eat his weight in food every single day, but that's not the whole truth. The whole truth is those Locust our food and you see, not only are they food, God said that the locust was not just food. It was clean food.

In Leviticus, where this is where all of the food laws are given in Leviticus 11:22, these you may eat. The locust after its kind. The destroying locust after it's canceled, he differentiated the different kind of locust. He said some kind of locust, okay, some kind of locust destroy stuff. He said you need it. He said the destroying locusts you may eat, the cricket after its kind and the grasshopper after its kind.

So, God covers four different kinds. He covers the regular locust, the destroying locust, the Cricket and the grasshopper. So, we got no excuse. God says, it's clean. But all other flying insects, which have four feet shall be an abomination to you. In the middle of all these locusts, billions of locusts, and God says they're clean.

I want you to play video number 3. You need to think about locusts the same way Bubba thought about shrimp. Play that video.

Male: Anyway, like I was saying, shrimp is the food of the sea. You can boil the shrimp, broil it, bake it, sauté it. These are shrimp kebabs, shrimp krill, shrimp gumbo and fried, deep fried, stir fried, these are pineapple and shrimp, lemon shrimp, coconut shrimp, pepper shrimp. Shrimp stew, shrimp salad, shrimp and potatoes, shrimp burger.

Nathaniel Bronner: Now the point is you can fix those locusts in just as many ways as Bubba could cook those shrimps, but he had to have his mind geared that this is food. Now, some of you when you were looking at those shrimps some of your mouth started watering, but understand this God says shrimp is an unclean food. He says locusts is a clean food, but because of the way our minds have been conditioned, we think that God says is unclean is clean. And that which God says is clean is unclean.

You notice how our minds have been switched up and change around. Now, the locust local hardly anybody in here could think about eating a grasshopper. But if we add some fried shrimp downstairs, the line would be wrapped around the building.

See that which God said was clean we abhor and that which God says is unclean is a delicacy to us. The world twisted our mind. So, in the middle of all of this plague, that's running through Africa, God has sent the locusts but its food for those whose minds are open. And you can barbecue it, you can fry, you can gumbo it, you can sauté, you can stir fry, you can cook them in all kind of ways.

Now, first of all, I have eaten grasshopper before. I don't know whether the brothers remember. We were -- I can't remember

where we were, but they had some fried grasshopper on the menu. And I said, I have never eaten fried grasshopper before, but I'm curious to see what this grasshopper taste like. So, I ordered and I don't think any of my other brothers ordered any grasshopper, but I ordered some grasshopper. I ordered the grasshopper and I ate the grasshopper, and I was surprised because the grasshoppers were good.

You see, our mindset changes how we perceive things. And even in the midst of plague, God has always sent salvation if you can see it if you know his words, but if you listening to the world, you would think these nasty things is no way in -- and most of the folks are going to starve to death with food swarming all around him. You need to have a Bubba mentality like that shrimp, and instead of coming out there with pesticide trying to kill him because they're just too many to kill, you need to be out there with a net.

You need to be out there with a net, you figure out a way how to catch him, you open up your stand, Locust Burgers, Locust Steak, you have Locust Salad. And you have a season like mayo, you have it peppered up, you have garlic on -- you have it fixed on, because people, the folk are going to be hungry. All of the other food is going to be gone, and think this is a mentality and this is what separates those who go to the top versus those who stayed and who were destroyed by the plague.

It's often a mindset. And even in the midst of this right now, even though this thing this had massive economic disasters, there's some folk who are going to figure how to make a fortune. They're going to come out of this thing reach and scream, because they'll see the food and not the famine. And it often depends upon how you view it.

So, every time right now you look at a grasshopper, you need to look at things in a different light. They even got chocolate covered grasshoppers. They do and this stuff taste good.

et me just read some of them healthy things about locust. Locust vary in protein content from about 50% to almost 60% making them denser in protein than steak. You didn't know that. So, when God says something is clean, it's good for you. Whenever God recommend something for you, it's all right. And whenever God says don't touch it is a reason why he said not to touch it.

So, locust is denser in protein than steak. Locust also contain adequate amounts of iodine, phosphorus iron, thymine, riboflavin niacin, as well as traces of calcium magnesium and selenium. Carbohydrate levels are very low which makes them a good candidate for Atkins and paleo types of diet.

So, if you want to go into Atkins or paleo diet, get you some locust. And this is the thing here, some people described cook locals as similar to smoky flavored bacon. You didn't know that. And if you don't have the knowledge, you'll be in the middle of a plague surrounded by food and you will starve to death.

You will starve to death. Here all of folk got all these swarms of locusts that God said is clean to eat 50% to 60% protein, all these other nutrients and all they got to do is catch them and cook them. And actually, some cultures don't even cook them. They just eat them raw and live. I mean it is a horror to our American way of thinking, but you got to admit that's fresh. That's fresh.

You got Amazon Fresh or you could or you could literally just pick the locust out, the leg just wiggling, it's fresh. Now see, it's difficult for us to even imagine that, but a lot of cultures eat the stuff fresh and anyone who's heavy into nutrition understands that even cooking destroys most of the live enzymes. You get all that stuff fresh, but you would have to re-gear your mind to that. And if it ever got to that, where we had local swarms and at least you all will have heard this message and you would have to say, I remember that message from Pastor Nathaniel, I'm hungry as I can be, all these locusts are flying right now, eating up all the food, nobody looking at me, but you will live.

And not only will you live, the scientific probability is you'll be healthier. You'll be healthier eating alive locust than a day at hamburger. But God said it was clean. And in the midst of all of these plagued with all of this food, what food is surrounding you right now that you haven't seen that you're looking down upon and God has sent in midst of your world right now, provisions for you that will take you through and beyond.

What have your eyes seen and recognized in the middle of this plague? It's there. We have to know his word and we have to do

and will often have to put aside what the world has told us, because often what the world has told us is exactly opposite to the truth.

And in the Book of Joel, second chapter beginning at the 25th verse, he talks about how even when he has sent all of this stuff, how he will redeem the people even in the middle of all of this and see this thing is -- right now what we're dealing with just in the US and so you all are to be thankful that you just dealing with the virus. Turn to the person -- just tell him, I'm thankful I'm just dealing with the virus.

See, you're just dealing with the virus. In Africa, they got to deal with the virus and massive swarms of locusts. It's how you do it. You ought to be thankful that you are just dealing with the virus because one of the things that was clear from the plagues of Egypt, all of the plague rooted out of the other plague. It started when the water was changed and out of the water came the frogs, and then the frogs infested everything, and from the frogs came to flies, and in from the flies came the pestilence, and then from the pestilence came to boils. And then from the boils comes hail. And then from the hail comes locusts.

We ought to be thankful that the only thing we're dealing with is just a virus and that still has not affected and will not affect the vast majority of people. But you have to be able to see the food that God has sent in the midst of the thing. You know God always had problems with people when he sent provisions. He sent all the locusts even in the wilderness when God sent the matter, you know God that problem with what was that matter, just had a problem with it just wouldn't do right they complain about the matter. Now, the matter(ph) kept them, there was no sick among them. Nobody got sick when they ate what God told him to eat.

When they ate just what God said, nobody got sick, but they went to complain because I'm tired of this. I want some variety.

Now see, right now, some of you still are shutting in and you can't partake of the things you used to partake of before this virus hit. You got to be able to see the blessing in the middle of that. If you're stuck at home, there's food all around you. You could have come out with a master's degree. If you were taking that time you were stuck at home and just used it to put forth on something positive.

You could have worked out three hours a day because you're stuck at home. You could have transformed yourself while being shut in or you can just look at it as the famine. I'm still key. I can't do nothing. Yes, you can do something. It just depends on what you decide to do and what you challenge yourself to do. And if you move out of the mindset of the masses and you move into the mindset that this locust is food.

If you move into the mindset that this virus thing, you're going to help me out a whole lot. I can make myself a way better by the time I come out of this house. Most people are going to come out of the house. They're going to stay there, watch TV. eat and sleep. So, they don't come out of the house in worse shape, mentally, spiritually, physically and financially, but you don't have to. If your mind is in a different direction, you can come out of that house in better shape tenfold than what you went in.

It's all a matter of what you can see. And hear in Joel 2:25, I will repay you for the years the locusts have eaten. The great locust and the young locust, the other locust and the locust swarm. My great army that I sent among you. Yeah, God sent it. You will have plenty to eat until you are full and you will praise the name of the Lord your God who has worked wonders for you never again will my people be shamed. Then you will know that I am an Israel, that I am the Lord your God and that there was no other never again will my people be shamed. And afterwards, I will pour out my spirit on all people.

Now, this is a verse we've heard over and over and over and over and over but we don't know where it comes from. We don't know it in context and afterward, I will pour out my spirit on all people your sons and daughters will prophesy. Your old men will dream dreams. Your young men will see Visions. Even on my servants both men and women, I will pour out my spirit in those days. I will show wonders in the heavens and on the earth blood and fire and billows of smoke. The sun will be turned into darkness and the moon to blood before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord and everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.

We said that verse, and your young men will see the old men but we didn't realize that was right after the locust and that was

right. After God said I will repay you for all of the days of the locust.

If we can envision it, we can do it and if we see it and if we do it will come out of this thing, not only will everything we have be restored, we will be better than we've ever been before. because whenever God sends a judgement, he always sends a redemption and as we move into the path and into the land of redemption, there's somebody right now and you just need to change the way you're viewing this pandemic.

You can't look at CNN and get a divine viewpoint of this. If you look at CNN, the only thing you're going to see is famine, but if you start communicating with God, he'll show you the food in the midst of the swarm.
