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Nathaniel Bronner: I believe that so many of you, you can have everything in your world upgraded if you would only do what God told you to do.

And now for "Jacob."

Nathaniel Bronner: Welcome to Brothers of the Word, because brother, you need the word. And on not the recent Saturday, but the Saturday before that, I was in my office. I often will go into the office and work on Saturday, and I'm the only person there because I don't allow anyone at the office on Saturday from sundown Friday to sundown Saturday is a Sabbath and nobody can come in that office and nobody can work. It's just a principle that we have in the company. You cannot work on a Sabbath Day, but I was out there working. The reason I work because Wednesday is my Sabbath Day. I take the one day a week of rest, but I take that on Wednesday instead of on Saturday.

I was at work. I was in my office and all of a sudden, the power went out, all the computers cut off, lights cut off, AC cut off, everything just turned off. The power stayed out for about a minute and then it came back on. And my computer didn't cut off because I have my computer on a universal power supply, but everything else cut off. But when the power came back on, my speakers just started buzzing. Like it's so loud, I had to just go reach in the back and turn off the speakers. I said, "What in the world was that? What lighting? Because the power just went out.

So a few days later, I'm trying to troubleshoot the speakers. I unplug everything to the speakers, turn the speakers on because they're powered speakers and the buzz is still there. So I figured, whatever it is did with this power going out, it blew something in the speakers and it's no need of me trying to take the speakers to get them repaired. It's cheaper just to go ahead and buy new set of speakers. So I went on the internet and searched and I ordered and purchased a new set of speakers. The speakers came in on Friday and I installed them. When I finished installing the speaker, I said, "My goodness, these speakers look good." The old

speakers were just solid black. These new speakers were red, mahogany wood grain. They had Bluetooth, so I could just connect my phone right up to it. It connected to my computer. They looked awesome. They had lights, they had volume control, they had equalizer control. It was just a whole different world from the old speakers I had in my office for years.

Then I heard God speak this, He said, "I am upgrading everything." I said, "What?" I said, "Everything? That's a lot of stuff." He said, "I am upgrading everything" and then I was away for this past week. I was at a business retreat. The retreat was on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. Started Wednesday about 4:30, I left the office about 2:00 because I didn't want to violate my rest day Wednesday, so I made sure I got in 24 hours. So I rested from 2 o'clock to 4:30 when the meeting start. So the meeting began at 4:30 on Wednesday.

Well on Thursday, we had four hours of training that morning, but that Thursday afternoon was varying activities. I chose to go on the hike and I happen to be the captain. I was the leader of the hiking team. And I chose the trail up in the mountain that was a little bit over five miles long. We started out on the trail and after we gone about three quarters of a mile, the ground in some areas was still a little wet because it rained prior. And as I was walking, there was some mud in my foot, slipped in the mud. I didn't fall, my foot just slipped about a couple of feet, but it twisted my left knee.

Now, I've told you all before, I have issues. My body just about -- no other issues, but his left knee. And sometimes that left knee when it hits a torsional force, it will twist. And that mud caused me to slip, it twisted my knee. My knee pulled, it started aching and I said to myself, "I'm 3/4 of a mile into this hike, I got over four miles to go and my knee is twisted." And I'm not walking on level ground, I'm walking in the woods, up and down hills through the mountain. So I'm walking with a hurt knee and I have to walk four miles. I walked for miles, got back, my knee aching. And I knew it takes about three to five days for this knee to stop aching whenever I pull it.

Saturday morning, God wakes me up real early because I've been thinking, I need to figure out some way to strengthen this knee. I found the exercise, I was trying to put my heels together and do

the leg raise it, it helps because I found out what was wrong with it.

Everybody knows about the ACL which is a ligament right in the middle of the knee. A lot of athletes have torn ACL as well. What I had was a LCL, it's a lateral ligament, it's right on the inside and that ligament is somehow damaged and weakens. I was trying to figure out an exercise that can strengthen that LCL.

God woke me up about four o'clock in the morning and he told me this, He said, "I told you years ago how to fix that. All you have to do is do 200 squats four times a week, or you can do them all in one day. You do 800 squats. I told you years ago how to fix that. And this light bulb popped over my head, he sure did. But you know, I want to do it my own way. Have you all ever had stuff that you just want to do it your own way? Anybody had a stuff like that might know somebody like that? I want to do this stuff my own way, thinking I want to do my own thing.

And God says, "I told you years ago how to fix that" and the light bulb just popped on in my head. All this time I've been pulling this -- and see, when I did it, I remembered, I never pulled a knee. And they're just half squats, all you do is do like this. I do half of them like this, and half of them I raise up on my calves. So that's all I have to do, 800 of those. That sounded like a lot, but I don't have any problem with doing that. But I hadn't been doing it, and as a result, I had been dealing with the pain and the embarrassment of limping with every pull of this left knee.

And some of you, God has told you got to fix your stuff, and sometimes it may not have come from a direct word from God. It may have come from the doctor. It may have come through your inner spirit, but God has somehow entered into your world how to fix your stuff, but you want to do your stuff your own way. And we live with the pain and the embarrassment because we refuse to do what God has told us to do. So when I woke up that Saturday morning, I got up. I did 800 squats. And right now, I can feel no pain. The knee is just perfect, but it was an upgrade

Ad the upgrade in that case, He said, "I'm upgrading everything. I'm not going to have any knee problems as long as I do the 800 squats a week. The upgrade was an upgrade in my revelation and

my understanding of what he'd already told me. See, some of this stuff, you all are waiting on a new revelation. You all want Prophet Deck just lay hands on -- Prophet Deck, you know one of the big problems we have with God heals, I know when I was doing God heals and God was speaking a word and the folk becoming --" And I asked, Did you do what God told you last time?" "No." "Why are you coming back for a new word, you haven't done what he told you last time.

So some of us, we want a new word and we haven't done what God told us to do on the last time. "I'm upgrading everything. And I believe right now that so many of you, you can have everything in your world upgraded if you would only do what God told you to do. Now, I'm in the middle of a series now called Success Forces. And I wanted to entitle today's message the Success Force of Legacy, but God said, "No, that's not the title." The title of today's message is just one word. And that one word is a name. No, it's not Jesus. I know y'all think it's going to be. No, it's not Jesus. It's Jacob

Abraham Isaac and Jacob this or these are the patriarchal series that we know. Now, it didn't begin with Abraham. Abraham's father was Tara, but most of us don't know anything about Tara. There's very little about Tara in the Bible, but Tara had a serious story all of himself. But to find out about Tara and to find out truly about the origin of Abraham, you have to read the Book of Jasher, which is outside of the Bible. It is mentioned in the Bible about the Book of Jasher.

But in the book of Jasher, it goes through the detail of Tara and the birth of Abraham. The king tried to kill -- (00:09:06) story about Abraham. Abraham had a time getting here because they tried to kill Abraham when he was born. So it's a whole story of the Book of Jasher about Abraham. But most of us don't know anything about Abraham's Daddy, just like I don't know much about my daddy's daddy because I never met my grandfather. My father was 40 years old when I was born, and by the time I was born, my grandfather had already transcended. I knew my grandmother on my father's side, but I never knew my grandfather on my daddy's side just like most of you don't know anything about Abraham's daddy who was Tara.

So my knowledge of the Bronner lineage begins with my father just like your knowledge of the triad of the patriarchal lineage. It

begins with Abraham. But we know Abraham, we know Isaac and we know Jacob.

And God told Abraham, "I am going to bless your seed" and God blessed Abraham's seed tremendously. That's a whole sermon about how widespread the seed of Abraham is and how much it is blessed. But the real impetus from this message came on Thursday. Came on Thursday, because on Thursday, I meet with all of the boys and we have a discussion and we have a study. On this particular Thursday, only Christian and George was at the meeting. The other two boys forgot, but they were doing something else, but they didn't show up.

As Christian and George began talking, Christian said, "On the first of this month, I began a 30-day consecration. I am only eating fruit and steamed vegetables. Nothing else. And water." He, said I'm watching no television. I'm going on no social media and I'm only listening to gospel music." And then George said, "On the first of this month, I began a 10-day consecration. I am watching no television. I am playing no video games and I am listening to only gospel music. And for the first five days, I am only eating fruit. And for the next five day, I'm only drinking water."

And I asked them, I said, "Did you all get together?" They said, "Nope." George said, "I didn't know Christian was doing it" and Christian said, "I didn't know George --" I said, "You mean to tell me both of you all started on the first of the month on some serious consecrations, and neither of you had consulted with any of the others." They said, "No, I was just led by God to just do it." That's what George said, that's what Christian said. So they both began this serious consecration independently. And I took George to his class on yesterday and I got him there a little early. That's one of the principles daddy tries to teach them. "Whatever you got to do, the successful people get there early."

So we were sitting there in the lot before the thing even open, early. And I had two headsets that I wear. I said, "George, I want you to tell me which one of these models of headsets sounds better. Then George says, "I can't even test it if it's not gospel music." And it kind of shook me a little bit, because the thing I was going to test it wasn't gospel music. So what happened when George said that it changed my whole music. I don't listen to any

wild out there, but sometimes I'll listen to instrumental, sometimes Jazz. Sometime I listen to some old soul music, I sure do.

But I noticed when George said that sitting in my car, I've only listen to gospel music since then. See, who you are around changes you. You find out that what they listen to influences what you listen to. And I notice that even though a lot of times I would listen to smooth, calming music, there's a different energy with gospel music. See, the smooth, jazzy, calming music, it will calm your nerves, but gospel changes your soul. There was a whole different energy with me changing to nothing but gospel music. And that happened just because of who I was around, a little child will lead you.

When I left George and he went into his class, I met with my oldest son. We went and had breakfast together. I asked him, I said, you give the prayer over to breakfast, and he prayed about a one-minute prayer. And I said, "My goodness, that's a serious prayer." And as I thought about it, God just begin dealing with me and I wanted to entitle this, The Success Force of Legacy, but it's Jacob. Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.

In the Bronner lineage, my father was Abraham. We didn't know Tara, we didn't know our grandfather. We only knew our father. And even though we knew and I knew my grandfather on my mother's side, and my mother is a great woman. But when you listen to any of us boys, 95% of the time when we talk about our parents is our daddy. And even my mother will say that. She said, "You all called your dad. Your daddy was the unusual power within this family." That's why God has always -- he looked into the hearts of men. That's why Pharaoh knew if he could destroy the boys, he could destroy the race. He understood that it's a principle that has never changed. But also, the principle is never changed, the enemy will always try to destroy the men. That has never changed either.

My father, Nathaniel was Abraham. Our generation which includes myself, my brother Bernard, my brother Daryl who has transitioned, my brother Dale, my brother C. Elijah and my brother James, we're the Isaac generation. But there's a Jacob generation, and that's the third generation with my father being

the first. As I begin thinking about this thing, we have a serious Jacob generation coming up. And that's why I've got these chairs right now just in the brothers of the word who attend this church and is not even counting the children of Bishop Dale. It's just those here today in this church. I want to ask those children to come up and sit in this chair.

First, Christina. This is the first child of my brother Bernard and she's on fire. As a matter of fact, God told me about a month ago, I'll be out of town. It'll be another two weeks. Sit right here. And he said for Christina to deliver the message. She does a thing on Facebook now every week where she just praised with such power. So Christina is the seed representing that Jacob generation. Next, C. Elijah's daughter, Elicia, if she would come up and sit in that chair right behind Christina. Now, Elicia, you've heard her speak here several times on Thursday. She does some of the prayer drives with her daddy C. Elijah. And she has her father's spirit because you can feel it when she talks with her passion.

But these kids also, they don't just have spiritual, they're academic. Christina is working on her master's degree. Elicia, I remember when C. Elijah was preaching once and Elicia's mother is an extreme academician. She may be a little bit more of an academician than C. Elijah, just a little bit, just a hair. But she is an extreme academician and that has flowed into the children. But I remember in particular, Elicia, who is the most spiritual of his children. I remember he was talking one night and he said that all of his kids had brought all of their grades and Elicia was snickering. And he asked Elicia what was she snickering about, and she said, "My lowest grade is higher than their highest grade." So it lets you know just because you are spiritual does not mean you don't perform well in the other stuff. So this is Elicia, the seed in the legacy of C. Elijah.

And then James, he has three who have immediately been recognized as following in that genre. That's Joseph, if he would come and sit there in that seat. And then Jamie, if she would come and sit in the middle seat and Genesis on that end seat. Now, they also represent extreme spirituality, but they also represent extreme excellence in the academic and in the world of performance. If you look at James and he'll talk about his kids, and he said, "Their discipline is just way beyond what he ever -- they've gone beyond the parent." And that's what happens a lot

of times. The kids will go beyond you in both good and bad, because they see the parent and they will magnify what they see the parents do good and bad.

So Joseph and Jamie and Genesis, they have a discipline that James said, he said it's just way beyond him. They get up early in the morning, then they do their exercise routine, then they do their praying, then they do their studying and they maintaining all these straight A averages. He told me about Genesis, he goes, she has like a 102 as her GPA. So there's extremely spiritual, but they're super academic. See, that's what we need in the world. We don't need every time when people see Christians, they'r all out of whack in every other area. We need to see them when they see Christian was, "I want to be like them in every single area of their life. They look good. They sound good. They're performing good. They're doing phenomenal in every single area of their life."

And then my two, which is Christian and George. I know Christian you're on the piano now, but if you would come and sit in that seat. And George, if you would come and sit in this seat So they have gone beyond daddy, because at the ages of 15 and 18, daddy wasn't even thinking about that. I'd be honest about it. Daddy was nowhere in that realm. I wasn't even thinking about that. So their levels of where they are moving at an early age lets us know that we're headed for some real deep stuff with this Jacob generation.

And we've had prophecy after prophecy, that this church is going to be overflowing so much so that we'll have to build a new sanctuary and the new sanctuary needs to be 4200 seats exactly, even including commodes. So 4200 seats exactly. But I'm thinking to myself, it has to be a supernatural move of God because there's no way we're going to do this in the natural. But then, as I thought about it, it may not be us. It may not be the Isaac generation. It may be the Jacob generation.

Now, I can't see in the natural us doing it, but I can see the Jacob generation do it. I can see with the dedication, with a fervor, with the spiritual blessing and hand of God that is upon them, I can see them doing it. And James was asking me about -- maybe we even need to think about a youth service and God spoke. And he said, "In three years, you'll look at a youth service. I remember

when he spoke about even starting the youth Sunday where we would have the youth speaker speak for 10 minutes. Ten minutes didn't make sense to me at the time, but I didn't understand at the time. It was two of them.

So sometimes God will tell you something but he rarely gives you the whole picture. And I remember God speaking years ago, he said, "When you need to go to two services, you shall not go to two services, you go to three services." So if we start another service, it won't be a youth service. It'll be two of them." I go, "I am not going to do two service." but we have enough to do two youth services at different times when that time comes to pass.

God also spoke even about this church. He said, "The Ark will never leave the Bronner bloodline." Now, you have to understand, in the Bible, the Bible is all about bloodlines. I don't care whether you begin with Genesis or you begin with Matthew. It all begins with a bloodline and it begins with such and such, begot, begot begot. It all flowed through one bloodline. And you need to look at your own bloodline. And sometimes, if you look at your bloodline, and there's some mess in your bloodline because there's some in everybody's bloodline. But sometimes, you may have to look at your own bloodline and you may have to say, "I'm going to be the Tare or the Abraham of my bloodline."

And sometimes you have to make it start with you, just like it had to start somewhere in my family. It has to start somewhere. Sometimes it'll have to start with you and you become the beginning of the bloodline, but you may not see the fruition of what it comes out to be. You may not see the Jerusalem rebuilt. You may not see the wall built. You may not even see the 4200 built. It may be the legacy of the seed of the Jacob generation.

So I asked them to come up here, and I know with God, he spoken a lot to me and I have four sons. I can see two of them heavily following God now. I heard my oldest son as he prayed yesterday, but the prophecy on him is he going to be like his daddy. Daddy took a while to come into the kingdom. I mean, daddy just took a while. And even though all of the prophecies were spoken, I remember when I was 22 years old, my father often bring in these speakers to talk with us to motivate to the whole company. And he had Judge Ziglar. Judge Ziglar was Zig Ziglar's brother. Zig Ziglar was the most famous motivational speaker on the planet and Judge Ziglar heard me speak a couple of times in our Tuesday

morning meetings. And he came to me and he said, “You got a gift.” He said I want you to come with me on our tour and we will take you around the world.” He Invited me to come with he and his brother. Zig Ziglar was the most famous motivator literally in the world and he said, “Come go with us.” He said, “All you got to do is develop one speech and you can deliver that speech over and over. But you have a gift, come go with us and we will take you around the world.”

It would have changed my whole world, but I didn’t have the mentality at the time. I didn’t want to go. I didn’t. I didn’t want to go. That was where I said in my last message, sometimes the opportunity of a lifetime must be taken advantage of in the lifetime of the opportunity and when it goes away, you miss it. Now, I don’t regret that because I did have a goal and a vision. I was building Bronner Brothers. I have a goal and a vision and a focus of what I was doing and I wasn’t going to get off that focus. And I did and I accomplished what I set out to do.

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But I did not come into the true calling of God until I heard God’s voice and I didn’t step into Ministry until I was 38 years old. I heard my oldest son pray yesterday and I said to myself, “This boy has a gift, but he’s probably like his daddy and he’s not going to acknowledge the call until down the road.” But see, it doesn’t matter when you come in, it matters that you come in. And there’s some of you right now and you got a call on your life and you’ve been told some stuff, you’ve been prophesied over, you just don’t want to do it, and you run from it. And I understand it because I ain’t got some stuff. Now, God just been telling me, “Oh no, focus on Coach Bronner.” I’m working on it. I don’t really like social media. I’m just going to tell you the truth. I really don’t.

So it’s hard for me to get into that mode because it’s just not my natural nature and I just don’t want to do it just like I didn’t want to go with Zig Ziglar. Some things you just don’t want to do and I just didn’t even want to do 800 squats, but I sure wish I had done it when that knee went out. This is the way God will work with so many of us. He’ll take us to a point where we wish we had listened.

I’m so delighted that we have a group of young people who are listening and sacrificing for God early. And it makes a difference

when you come in and see when you do stuff early and when you stop following God early, you don't have to go through all these painful detours. And sometimes, the painful detours cost us and we learn and we eventually get there, but we're so beat up by the time we get to it. And it's a blessing to get there, but I will always say, that's why I'm such an advocate about health. I don't want a healing testimony. I can talk to you about this knee, but if I hadn't done what God had told me to do from the beginning, I wouldn't have been talking about this knee. And it's a lot better to be kept didn't have to be brought back. Just a lot better cause you don't have to go through all the pain, and the trauma and the fear dealing with the thing.

So I wanted to present to you today the Jacob generation. Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, and I believe they're going to change the world. And God also spoke this to because sometimes with the children, you don't know which one is going to do what. And God spoke this, He said, "It only takes one. It only takes one." And sometimes, you don't know in truth who that one going to be. Jesus had a pile of brothers and probably some sisters because often they didn't tell you about their women, they only tell you about their sons. My son, Josie is named after the brother of Jesus, but you ain't heard nothing Josie then. Jesus had a brother named James. You ain't heard nothing James then, but you know what Jesus did.

It only takes one. And often, you don't know which one will be the one who will blossom and who will change the world. But I believe that with this Jacob generation, they will work together because there is so much power an unity, and they're coming from a platform where they have seen three brothers work together all of these years with no friction and with no conflict. So when you see it, you know that it can be done. And I am just delighted to have them here and I'm going to just ask each one of them starting with the oldest over to the youngest. I'm going to ask each one of them just to take two minutes, limited to two minutes. And just whatever is on their heart, I want you to hear one by one from this next generation.

Someone will say, "Yes, that's the Bronner's. Yeah, they're Bronner's, there's no question about it. Everyone with last name Bronner, there's no question about that." But do you know, in the Bible, you could only be a priest if you were in the bloodline, and I don't know what kind of blood my other brothers got, but I got

certified rare blood. Actually, I told you about that one. I've got a card from the Red Cross, I am a member of the American Rare Donor's Program. My blood is one in a million. So it's rare blood that flows through these children, without question and I believe they're going to do something that's going to change the world. But I believe each one of you has the same potential and if it has not begun, you can be the Abraham of your lineage and legacy.

I'm going to ask her start with Christina and two minutes, whatever you would like to say.

Christina: Well, good morning. I am the oldest of the third generation up here on the stage today. Also, like Christian and George, I am 42.

Nathaniel Bronner: Wow. Wow.

Christina: So in addition to their fasting and consecration, I am on day 30 of 42. This is what 23 lbs lighter looks like.

Christina: It's absolutely amazing, because this during this journey, God has really, really been able to speak to me and I've been able to spend intimate and quality time with him. He reveals some things that we don't understand. For those of you that followed my Thursday prayer, which I do at every Thursday, 6:30. November will make three years, and I have not missed a Thursday except once and I was in the hospital. But I have not missed any other Thursday, so it is absolutely a blessing. I know that he is going to do some might, mighty amazing things with this third generation as he continues to speak through each and every one of us. I am proud to be part of this legacy, part of this family and part of this third-generation.

Nathaniel Bronner: Tell them exactly how to find your Thursday prayer. Time, place, tell them exactly how to get there.

Christina: So you become my friend on Facebook. For those of you that are not friends with me, you can find me by, I think it's facebook/christina.christina.792 and it will pull up my page. And every Thursday morning at 6:30 on the dot, I've been last twice, at 6:31. At 6:30 on the dot, it will pop up and say, "Christina is

live” and I am there with whatever God has placed in my spirit, and we pray. I also post the day before. So those people who have prayer request, you can submit your prayer request and we get to pray them.

Nathaniel Bronner: Amen.

Elicia: Good morning, everyone. Oh gosh, the Lord is so good and he has been doing so many good things this year, even though it's been a hard year, it's been a good year. And if you're like me, this year has prompted you to go deeper with the Lord. And I think the best thing about going through something that we don't know what it is, we don't know what we're facing, is that we go to the one who does. We go to the one who knows all, and sees all, who goes before us in all things. So the Lord has really just been like, “Hey, you need to go deeper in me. You need to make sure that you are rooted so firmly and so deeply in me.” Because what we've seen so far is just the beginning there are more things coming and it's our roots are not so deep in Him, we will be shaken and we will fall. So we need to be so deeply rooted in the Lord and that is the only way that we will stay in.

So get in your word, get in your prayer closets. Pray with Christian at 6:30 AM every Thursday morning. Pray on your own every morning and throughout every day. The word tells us to pray without ceasing. That is the Lord with a heart that is yearning for intimacy with you without ceasing. He is with us every moment of every day, but we're not acknowledging him if we're not seeking him every moment of every day and you don't even recognize that he's with you. So pray without ceasing, get in word, stand, be so deeply rooted in the Lord because there is so much coming that he wants us to be prepared and we can only be prepared if we're rooted in him. So God bless you guys. The Lord is good. Just hang on to that and he is good and he is faithful.

Joseph: Oh, hello, everyone. Can hear me? Yeah. Can you hear me? Hello, everyone. I'm pretty sure you guys kind of know me because I sang this morning, but I'm the son of James Bronner. First thing I got to say is that, a lot of the things that God has done in our lives. I've even noticed in my own life that a lot of the blessings God has given to me is because of my father. Even whenever I was running away from God, even whenever I felt like

I might become his enemy, God spoke through to me I felt like because of my dad and my mom and the things that they sacrifice so that God could actually flow through me. So I just want to say thank you so much for everything that you've done. As Uncle Nathaniel was talking about with that legacy stuff. That's very important, yeah.

And I will say, my life motto is literally this, it's exactly how I think. Number one, submit unto God and number two, do your best in everything that you do. Because if you miss either of those you won't be able to go along the track that God wants you to go on. It doesn't mean that you just have to beat your head at the wall, but really do what you need to do in every single moment and you can change and grow as the storyline like God has you going on. And as Uncle Nathaniel said, all it takes is one, but that's not what I believe. I believe that all of us are going to be together.

In order to get the best of what God has for us, it's going to take all of us. And so one of my dreams, one of my goals at the end of my life, I have to accomplish this before I leave this earth. I want whenever I die, whenever I have my descendants that the devil trembles whenever any of them even enter into the room. So it's going to take some extra work to get there. Amen. That's my piece.

Nathaniel Bronner: Okay. In the same household, you can use the same mic. Jamie next, and then Genesis.
