I want to welcome you to the broadcast today whether you are watching on television or tuning in via the internet, via the onlineword.com or virtualchurch.com, welcome today.

Today is youth Sunday here in the Arch of Salvation and I plan to speak today primarily to the youth in my message. We have to be sensitive to the spirit and God gave me a message in spare primarily to the parent on today. Most of our themes on today's time, most of the parent before they leave out of their teenage years, so we have a lot of things here today that this message will also be applicable too. If

you are a child here today and your parent is not here, I am going to ask that you give a tape of this message and take it back to them or get on the onlineword.com and allow them to listen to this message. If the parents would hear this message it will bless the children in the process. The message is to the parent but it is for the children. Because the parents are the child's greatest teacher and your kids are with us and fund in school, and church and children's church probably about two to four hours a week, but in your homes, there are the 6 days, and 20 hours a week.

My brother Bishop Dale, he was pointing one day about his youth ministry and he was asking God how to stop the youth from getting pregnant so much and having babies out of wedlock and from using drugs and being disrespectful to the authority. He was expecting to receive from deep answer and some technique that would recent society of the young people today. To fully reach them but instead God gave them an answer that he was not expecting. The answer God given that I have ordained the responsibility for raising children and the parent's hands and not the church.

We a lot of times bring our children to church dropping to mouth saying, you raised my children but God and His order had he said a thing have made you the authority over your children and responsible for your own households. Today, I ask the parents to hear the word of the Lord, and I will make a charge to you as I speak from the subject of home training.

You can never get to modern to just good old fashion home training. I do not see how fast the computer is getting the internet all over the world, the technology you can never get too old to just good old country, old fashioned home training. The old folk say they use to tell kids when they were asking enough for not using proper attitude or just being rude it is kind of like you got some home training. Today, the reason that a lot of our youth are going crazy, and acting like they do not have any home training it is because they do not.

Solomon, the wisest man that ever lived, he asked for wisdom from God, but it was a Saba that taught him to get welcomed. Proverbs 4 1 read, "Hear you children they discretion of a father, and attend to know understanding, for I give you good doctrine forsaking not my law. For I was my father's son, tender and honored the love and the side of my mother". He told me also and said unto me, "Let thy heart retain my word, pick my commandments and leave", that is wisdom, then understanding.

Forget it not and he is a decline form the words to my mouth. Forsake her not and she shall preserve the love for him, she shall keep the wisdom is the possible thing, therefore get wisdom and before by getting that understanding, exalt her and she shall promote thee. She shall bring thee to honor when vow does not brief her. She shall give to them hate and honor mental brief, the prawn of glory, shall she deliver

to thee. Here, all my son and receive my thing, and the years of our life shall be minute. I have halted thee and the way of wisdom, I have leaded the upright path, when they go as I said shall be straightened and when by running. Thou shall not struggle, take fast hold of an instruction, let her not go, and keep her for she is right. These were words by Solomon preferring to words his father David gave him, concerning wisdom.

When God asks Solomon; child, but one thing in all the world can I do for you and give to you. There was no accident that Solomon all listed here going in and spared with son get wisdom, wisdom, wisdom, wisdom, grasp hold of wisdom. It will guide your paths son above all out. Where is the wisdom, that thing we know actually that Lord I desire wisdom.

The king, the wisest man that had ever lived. Proverbs 22:6 says, Training up a child and the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from you. Now you read that again. In Proverbs 22:6 again says, Training up a child and the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from you. Turn to your neighbor and tell them we are talking about home training today.

As many times as you have read that verse, I want you to look at it carefully. The Bible did not say as you may have read it in your mind, it did not say that tell a child in the way that they should go and when they are old they are not depart from. It is said to train our child and there is a big difference when you train somebody on the job, you bring in a new person and the first thing you do is to set him down and you show them how to do the test correctly. The second thing you do is to watch them try to do it correctly, the third thing is you go back and correct them and show them what they did wrong and again how to do it correctly. You do that over and over and many times does not take.

To some employees you have to go to some point in time. To show it on the fourth they did it right and that is the difference in training versus just telling. We wonder today if our children can understand the Bible. You cannot learn how to play basketball by just reading about it. You can read about the rules and says do this and do not do that and get all of these things from the book on basketball, but you will never be a top-notch player, until somebody was from basketball field, like seen a lot and take you out and show you how to dribble ball and let go behind your back with it.

You will never be a top-notch player until you get out on the court and show you how to do a lay-up properly and teach you how to play. You cannot learn how to play an instrument way all from the book alone, you must hear somebody, like Brother Ivan, who has rhythm, you cannot listen just to anybody, you have to listen with somebody with some rhythm, you have to listen to rhythm to be able to understand and feel the rhythm, to begin training to take place. To become a

doctor, you must go through four years of college and four years of medical school, but you just do not go straight and practicing medicine from there. You have to go through at least three years of residency and on residency you have to go around with an experienced doctor, to see patients and diagnosed them and you will have to be evaluated and corrected and you have to learn diseases one by one, learn symptoms, one by one, training.

It is no wonder why a child cannot understand love, if he sees mama and daddy at each other throat. It is no wonder why a child cannot understand charity, when they see mama and daddy is not helping somebody who is in need. It is no wonder why a child cannot understand forgiveness, when mama and aunty have not talked in years. Some of you may not like this message, this morning, but can I say, God send me to give it to you.

It no wonder a child cannot understand patience, when the parent is out in traffic, buzzing their horns, calling all people idiots, when they get to the grocery store in a line, and line into the front, why are you here, common and get out of here. It is no wonder why children have no patience and cannot understand when they read it in the word. If we want the children to understand, the Bible, we must demonstrate it to them.

When we talk prayers out of schools it should not have been taken prayers out of the kids, because the primary point that the child should learn the prayer and pray religiously at home if school was the place where your child was praying, they were missing something anyway. Justice of parents has blamed the church, they blamed the school for saying that God has placed in their own responsibility and people also asked my mother how they had four sons to go into the Ministry and they tell her that she need to write a book about it. They asked how did she get the second and raise them to run a business, as well as the first generation and then after that question, that my mother gave them is, by example.

My mother and father did not do a whole lot of talking to be about the right thing, they just did a whole lot of demonstrating to write things to me. My father never asked me to read a book on business; instead he helped to start my own business, which was paper rack, when I was five years old. I learned how to sell papers before I even learned how to ride a bicycle and I would go out everyday and have to walk that paper out before I opt to school by myself, all up and down the street, at five years old, everyday.

I learned from that paper rack, how to deliver good for people for money. I learned how to send my bills and collect on those bills. My father started the first employee matching 4401 case land, whatever I would sell he would match it, dollar for dollar in the Credit Union and that was 4401 case land even existed or even thought of and that inspired me to save when I was beaten over the head to tell me not to

spend my money on all those privilege things and the only allowance that he gave any of his sons, was the allowance to make our own money.

And, some of you even need to hear the story and you just look after the day on television or in the culprit on you. You do not know the story of what made her, who we are on the Lord. At the age of ten, I started working in Warner Brothers Inn, my father, he has been starting me in the office, like a lot of employees thought they said, "well, you are going to start in your up-way there, I will get ready to get this place." My father started by cleaning the floor and I went on from sweeping the floor to sitting at the table with feeling light and we had B&B stickers that we would have to put on the top of the Super Bros., all day long.

I do not even say we have been paid of out of minimum wage, back then. I was old enough to know salaries so the government to get my salary waiving. And, I went home from putting on the lose sticker to working on the assembly line, holding the job under the machine to feel, with grief and then, I was promoted, big time, to shipping department, holding boxes all day long, packing them up, wrapping them up, zipping them out. Then, I moved on working with the salesmen out on the field, learning how to sell a product. Then I went on to the laboratory for organizing the chemical and mixed it up, then I finally moved to the office, after all of that, but by the time that I got to the office I have spent a summer in every area of that business and I knew the business, how it worked, because I had worked in every area of it.

I did not read a book on business and know how business work. I have to get in and do every person's job that was in that Company and I learned through training. Just turn to your neighbor and say "Home Training." My mother, she did not forced me to go to church four times a week and learn about prayer and scripture at church, instead, she walked me to school, five days a week and we both recited scripture for memory all the way to school.

My mother never asked me to read a book on class, instead, she got up at 6 am, every morning with a prayer prepared for 25 straight years and called down the blessings from heaven, upon her household to cover it in prayer. And, there were mornings that I can still remember, my mother up praying forever and the spirit. I was still sleeping in the bed and I can remember my room been below her that I can remember that morning from her room and that prayers just followed through the floor and come to my ceiling while I was asleep that morning rest on me and saved me and sad, "Son get up, somebody upstairs in a seeding on your behalf." I could not get that out from a book; mama had to get up and pray to bring her children through and to teach them, prayer.

My mother did not do any lecturing on being peace maker, instead when he business pressured, cam down heavy upon my father and he blew up at my mother, lost his temper. My mother, she held her tongue, my daddy end up just tossing and

he would not say anything, he was frustrating, he had to tell her what she was thinking. He would not say anything, it is hard to argue by yourself, he had to bring her on the other side, I know what you are thinking over that look on me he would tell her what she was thinking and then he got to go back and argue back against that. And, it showed me as a child that silliness of anger, and the, she would go back into her room and get on her knees and prayed for her husband and it shown me how God can fight the battle.

My mother never took me to a lot of healing crusades, when I was little. Instead, one day, when my father, he was in the bathroom he running and ran and hit his little toe on the tub and disjoint the bone in his toe and as he came back and sat on the bed, and getting ready going to the hospital, mama said, "No wait, let me pray," and mama who has been rising up at 6am, feel with the power of God, as she caught her hand on daddy's disjointed toe, she said, "I could feel the bones jumped into place."

I could not get that out from reading about faith, I had to train, demonstrated on how we serve a God, that heal and even though, 1st Corinthians 13 of a powerful chapter on love, I learned the meaning of charity, from watching my mother drive her Mercedes Benz into the project, filling it with kids, still dirty from playing outside, the triumph day and I saw her going knock on the door and there were community and drug dealers would open the door and see did it without fear, and say, "You are not going to straighten up and get great, at least for the children out, so they can feed and the drug dealers have to, even though they did not know God, they stop law-demonstrating and even they respect it and they went in and woke up the little ones and set hem out and say, "I do not know this lady, but go with her because I can see something in her that is demonstrating the love of God unto me."

And, she did not send me to Bible College, instead, she moved out a fancy dinning room and chairs and she put up folding chair in the dinning and living room, we had Bible class every Thursday in the home and Bishop David Brown, church for first thirteen years, al that minister right there, the living and dining room. Even though I was a virgin when I marry, I can never remember my father talking to me about sex, but big brothers and sisters are then, you have a responsibility too, what I did have was two brothers closest to me in age, they waited for the soul mates and count the bed undefiled to marriage and they took me and showed me through praying and said, "Little brother, look at what God had brought me through and through and look at the soul mate that he has given me, look at what God has done in my life and in my marriage and they demonstrated it to me without one lecture on sex, it was demonstrated, the glory of God upon the relationship. And, when I begin dating, finally, my mama nor daddy gave me a curfew, but what mama did was she got me connected me to the Master of above. She got me in a relationship with him, where I knew in my self and without a curfew, she said, "Son, your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost and if you just stand out there, that is going to mess

with your connection to your heavenly father and over creed the Holy Spirit that dwells within you.

From then, I valued that relationship with my Heavenly Father so much, that it was a greater value to me than a quite playing in the bed, I was not out running in the street, and I was able to come home on time, even without having a curfew. Can somebody in here say, "Home Clean," and sometimes hearing this message, are saying, "Please Sir I do not know how to properly train a cow," well, I am here to tell you, that is why God sent me here today, and I want to give you quickly six pointers for properly training your children and for the television audience I am out of chimes but you can hear this message and it is entire to you. That is the benefit of being here today, you get to hear this six points quicker. Part one: on properly training your children is to be the best example of what you tell them to do. Parents want to tell their children, do not smoke, but yet, they see mama or daddy, puffing a cigarette, the visual training, the actions speaks so loud, they can not hear a word that just screamed. They want to tell the children, "Son, when you get a job, you need to be on time for the job, you need to do this and that," but yet, the parents bring them late for church, Sunday after Sunday and late for this and late for that, they do not remember the timeliness that the parents pass them on. The parent tell their children, "Child, always be honest," but yet, they will see daddy saying, "I will take to a ball game next week," and next week rolling around and daddy is out all the time, they learn not to trust the word daddy. Part one is to be the best example, before you tell them to do.

Part two: write down your life lessons into a book of wisdom. There are a lot of books in the world today, but there will be no book, besides the Bible that will impact the lives of you children than your own wisdom. Whenever I learned something, whether at work, at home, at church, I write in into a journal and call it my own personal book of wisdom and when my children get of age, and when I leave the earth, my wisdom, as solemn, will still be in the earth to pass unto my children and they can pass it to their grandchildren. We learn so many lessons but after we are gone, the lesson is lost, because it is not written. Imagine if this word was not written, how much of the lessons and the wisdom would be in it, today. To learn from the word as these men are told to write it down. You need to write down your own wisdom, write down your own proverbs, your own song and pass it unto your children.

Part three: you need to pray with your kids. Every night that you are home, you need to be praying with your kids, if you can, that is the best place that they are going to learn how to pray, is with mom and daddy and not only when they teach him how to pray, when they get into trouble they will know, "No," and said, "Daddy, I heard mama, we were going through financial, he prayed this way and that way, when his body was rocking in pain with prayer, he prayed like this, they know from the training the demonstration them and not only that, when they have their children of their own, they will say, I remember growing, as daddy always pray for me, mama always pray for me and I am going to pray with my children and I will pass it from generation to generation. This a lot of revelation, this is 3 o'clock in the morning stuff here, this is fresh word.

Part four: training them in your trade. This is an old practice as the people used to do, whatever mama or daddy was doing as a profession they would train the children and at least as the children went on and wanted to do their own thing and they wanted to go out and to be an artist and the thing did not worked out for him, and nobody was buying the paintings, at least they were safe, "I can still make a living, because daddy has been training me on how to fix things, his training me on how to make machines work and they can fall back on the training of a train. And, I want my kids, by the time they are on the teen age years, they will know everything that I know about computers, I am going to training them, on my plead.

Part five: perform and display a household mission statement in your house. You all work this up, let me see the hands of the job that you worked, even if it is not displayed, you know that confident, that somewhere along the line or somewhere that has a mission statement and that is 90% of the hands out here, so it is the world can have that much vision to write down over a mission and post it. How much more should your household have a vision, that the children can grow up seeing and saying, "This is a vision and the mission that a set for this household," and a lot of women today, they cannot submit to the man, because of the mission, now, I do not know what the mission is, how can you get on to something, and you do not even know what it is.

So, write a mission statement for your house and post it where the children can see it going out and coming in. the final part, six, teach them the what, and when you want to make children do something, just because you said so all of the time, then when get out under your roof or you get out-of-town, they would not understand, why they were doing something and they will stop doing it and get away from it. My father, did not just make us eat our green vegetables, he took us to numerous health seminars, all over the country to hear the best and told us what was good and bad, for our body and it stuck with us and I knew the what and when I got ready to choose my own diet, that away from mama and daddy, those teachings, trainings through the years, it was convincing me when I would poison and now I know and they were in my veins, because I knew the what. I did not have the

conviction of saying, "Because daddy said so I had to eat it," but I knew what the poisons were doing to my system. And, I have been a vegetarian now, since I got out of high school, because I understood the why, never forced from mother or father.

In the old days, last names, actually described what your training was in. If your last was Smith, you knew how to be a Blacksmith. If your last name was farmer, you knew how to grow food. If your last name was Hunter, you knew how to hunt game. Not only these fathers would give their children their last names, but they gave them the training associated with their names. And, the very destiny or steel was very evident in the name and even the child did not know or even want to do exactly what daddy did, their own plans did not work out, they could fall back on the trainings that they have learned from their parents. Nowadays some kids, if you ask them, "What does mama exactly do everyday at work?" They hardly tell you, they just say, "I know she work in this department," but they could not give you details of exactly what mom and daddy does.

So, training up your child and even our savior, the Lord Jesus, he followed his heavenly Father's will, but he began as a carpenter from the training of his earthly father and after that, that as a carpenter, trained by his father he became the cornerstone that the bill has rejected. It is no accident, it was in it destined. So, I as leave today, again I place the charge to your parents, just as if you place charge unto your school to teach your children. The church to teach your children. The ball is in your hands, is in your court, God has given you the responsibility. Training-up your children, in the way that they should go, training them off, training-up the way they should go and when they were old, they shall not depart from it. God bless you.
