And now for 8245, "See, Write, Run."

James Bronner: Welcome to Brothers of the Word because brother, you need the word. Stay tuned today whether you are watching this on television or listening live over the internet or Facebook.

I believe that God has a word for you today that will help you to get to the next level in your life. Those things that you might have been waiting on prophetically that hasn't manifested yet. I believe this message will give you that push to get you into your season of manifestation. And even this past week, the mayor of the City of Atlanta, he came out to our business, Bronner Brothers, and he presented us with the highest honor of Atlanta which is the Phoenix Award. So, we were very honored to receive that award of the family. And even as we spend over an hour this week with the mayor and receiving that honor, that same anointing that calls that honor from God is on me today and I speak not just from something that I've read or something that just I believe in. But this is something that we're walking in in a day-to-day walk.

And I want to give you three steps today that all major corporations and organizations have to go through to get to their goals and their promised land. And these are the same three steps that apply to you as individuals that you have to go through to get where God wants to take you. And they have a big movie that came out this year that's recent called, "Get Out."

I'm not preaching about Get Out today but I want you to get there. So, in there is your promised land, that place of promise, that place of destiny, that place of purpose in your life. And all three steps can be found in one verse of scripture that we'll deal with today and it comes from Habakkuk 2 starting at Verse 1 and I'm going to read from the New King James Version. It says, "I will

stand my watch and set myself on the rampart, and watch to see what He will say to me and what I will answer when I am corrected. Then the Lord answered me and said, 'Write the vision and make it plain on tablets, that he may run who reads it. For the vision is yet for an appointed time. But at the end, it will speak and it will not lie. Though it tarry, wait for it because it will surely come, it will not tarry.'"

And I speak to you today on a cellphone three-word process that will take you to your destiny if you follow it. And coming from that second verse of Habakkuk Chapter 2, my title today is the three words of, "See, Write, Run." Turn to your neighbor and tell them, "See. Write. Run." Turn to the other side and tell them, "See. Write. Run." And you have to see the vision then you have to write it out making it plain and then you have to run with it. See, write and run. And these are the same three steps that it takes to deliver a sermon. And seeing is like getting the subject matter from God.

God -- when you're praying or studying, He will give you a revelation that you'll grab a hold of and this is equivalent to that step of seeing. And once you get your subject matter, then you have to study and read, meditate on it, and to get a written outline and the details and the meat of what you're going to speak about and that is that written portion. Then, once you get that second one, then you have to preach it. And that's like the running. That's what I'm doing right now. And if you live out any of these steps, God's people won't properly get the word.

If you don't get the revelation from God, then what you preach won't be a quicken word from God for God knows what the people need to hear at that moment. If you don't study and outline it out, then you will lose depth and revelation and insight to be able to properly cover the subject and to change lives. And if you don't preach it after you get the revelation and after you study, then all of that revelation and study goes out of the window because the people will never hear it.

Next, I want to just walk you through in detail how to see, how to write and how to run. Let's start with how to see. And that's vision. Vision needs to have two qualities. Both qualities start with the letter C, which is what S-E-E spells out phonetically, see.

Those two words are the vision needs to be clear and correct. And how do you see a clear and correct vision? Habakkuk 2:1 says, "Watch to see what He will say."

When a soldier is on watch, they can't be fumbling around with their phone and reading the newspaper and looking at television and talking to their cohorts. They have to pay attention and watch out for what is coming and they have to listen and tune in their ears even the quietest of sounds to be on guard. And when I watched to see what God is saying to me, I have to eliminate all distractions from my life. I have to lock myself in my prayer closet and turn off my cellphone and turn off the television and the radio and I have to tune in to God.

Jesus said in Revelation 3:20, "Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him and he with me." And how many of you like to go out with people to eat and take them out to dinner and they're sitting down on their cellphones or not paying attention to you? How many of your parents like to sit down at the dinner table with your children and they're fumbling on their cellphones while you're trying to dine with them? That's the same way God is, that He wants to come in and sup and dine with us. So, we have to give Him our attention.

And when I lock into my prayer closet and cut off all distractions, I get still and quiet and focus on His voice and His vision. And I begin to just in the stillness of the hour begin to watch and see what impressions that He'll flash before my spiritual life to see what words He'll bring to my spiritual ears to see what revelations that He'll bring into my spirit. And I can tell you, you can't be on a rush. We serve a god that you cannot rush. Now, you made me on a rush but you can't rush Him. He is not in a rush. So, you've got to be patient with Him.

Our show manager, Erica(ph) is here and I heard her telling somebody the other day to meet her boss. She said that, "My boss works better overnight because there's something about him when he goes and sleeps and then wake up and prays that he'll come back into the office with clear vision and strategy, and it is his best work." And even when I was in prayer recently, God gave me a revelation that as He was just pouring things into my spirit, He almost equated it to our modern smartphones today. Without modern smartphones, they update only in the stillness of the

night when you're not on this phone. And they begin to get new patches to fix it from viruses and get new features updating over the air. And these updates come from those who made the software whether Apple or Google with Android. And the phone becomes updated and it becomes better because it tunes in to its manufacturer, its Maker in the stillness of the night. And it is the same way with us when we get still and tune in to our maker that He will begin to update things and your spirit and give you revelations, and give you solutions to your problems, and begin to allow you to help you to figure things out. And he will begin to soothe things that you're worried about in these updates.

When a phone does not get these updates for an extended period of time, it becomes open to viruses and all type of malware. The same way it is with us when we don't take time they get still before Him, we begin to open up to all type of attacks. So, this is how He wants us to be upgraded in the stillness and listening and focusing in to our Creator. He will begin to upgrade you from the inside. I know Beyonce sang a song about upgrading you but nobody can upgrade you like the master who created you.

I had a stylist contacted me recently on Facebook and they asked, "Can you mentor me?" And I explained to him, "You know, I'm mentoring several people right now and I'm doing so many things. I really don't have the time to personally mentor anybody new right now." And I gave them some material that will kind of guide them along the way and they wrote me back and say, "I've read most of this and I've been doing most of the things that you wrote already and I still can't get ahead."

And I prayed about it and I wrote her back and I said, "I don't know what your spiritual foundation is like. But to be honest, in our company, most of the big breakthroughs didn't come from reading books, didn't come from school, but it came because of a connection with our Creator that gave us ideas of innovations." And I said, "You're going to have to push back your plate. I know you don't want to hear it but you've got to go on off-air(ph), you've got to set yourself off from all the distractions of the world. And when you tune in to Him, get connected, He will give you something fresh that you can't get in a classroom, that you can't get in a book, that even I as a mentor can't give you. He'll give you innovation in your own area that will propel your life." And

she thanked me so much for that advice. We have to be connected to get upgraded.

Here are some other ways that God can give you clear and correct vision. One way is through prophesy. Prophesy -- now, don't just run with one specific prophetic word on your life. If it's something major, you should either be confirmed already in your spirit or it should be confirmed in the mouths of two or three witnesses as 2nd Corinthians 13:1 talks about.

Another way is through dreams. Again, it needs to be confirmed to make sure it wasn't the meatloaf you ate last night that was speaking to you while you slept. Another way is through visions. And visions are moving images similar or still images. They are almost like dreams while you're wide awake. Another way is through signs. And this also needs confirmation because the devil can send you what appears to be a sign from God Himself. And I tell you and I've seen it so many times that if you want something bad enough, people can make a sign almost out of anything. You can find women that's desperate to get a man and they'll pray to the Lord and say, "Lord, if it's meant for this man here to be mine, then let the grass be filled with dew in the morning." You have to be careful with sign because you can find whatever you're looking for if you want it bad enough.

Let me move on to the second one, how to write, how to write. Habakkuk 2:2 says, "To write the vision and make it plain." God gave me this revelation that I had never read or heard before, so I was meditating on this message asking Him how do the people make the vision plain. And He showed me that word "plain" there and He basically dropped in to my spirit that the vision comes from me, God. And too many times, people will put their own self in the vision and making their own plans and their own way, too much "I" in it. And when you remove the "I" out of plain, it spells plan. And if you remove the "I" out of it, you make it plan. You make a plan. And that's how you make it plain. It's God's vision.

When we submit into His will and say, "Lord, not my plan but thy plan." Then, He will begin to give you strategy and plan to make the vision clear. You need a strategic and a comprehensive plan. Listen to this, "God will give you the vision but He won't write the plan nor will He do the running." Let me repeat that, "God will give you the vision but He will not write the plan nor will He do the running for you."

And in our company, Bronner Brothers, we spend time away from the office each year and we go on what's called, "A Strategic Planning Retreat." We bring in experts that present our relevant data and information dealing with our industry, and we also bring in outside advisers that have successful experience in whatever area we're trying to move into for that year. And we leave with a well-thought-out strategic plan for the year with who is responsible for what and by what date. But we start that retreat with defining a clear vision for the year of where we want to go. Then, we leave and then we roll up our sleeves and get to work to make the vision and the plan happen. And we used the same three steps in a multimillion-dollar business that God outlined there in Habakkuk 2:2 to see, write and run.

Here are some of the components of a great plan. The first thing is strategy. Strategy is a method to bring about success. So, you don't just need a plan. It needs to have a great strategy, some really creative thinking into it, a technique to it that will get you to success.

The next thing is resources. You got to figure out how you're going to pay for this thing. Almost all big visions need outside resources.

The next one is people. Most big visions -- it is a vision that's large enough. You can't do it by yourself. It takes other people. So, part of the plan is writing in what types of people and who you need to help you to bring the vision to pass.

The next one is timed actions. Things that you need to do in certain periods of time to make the vision to come to reality. The next thing is it needs to be realistic, realistic. They took 1000-person survey and asked them what their plans were for their retirement. And they found to their amazement in these 1000-person survey that 20% of their plans -- you know what it was? It was to hit the lottery to pay for their retirement. They had a plan. They had a vision. But the problem was, it wasn't realistic.

And with God, He rarely will give you the full plan ahead of time. But you can't ask what skills are needed at my destiny and begin to train for that. If He has called you to preach, you know you'll

need to study His word, you know you'll need to increase your prayer life and develop a closer relationship with Him. You can join toastmasters and begin to work on your speaking gift. If He has called you to be a schoolteacher, then you know you're going to need a degree, you know you're going to need a certification to do that. So, whatever it is He has called, you might not know all of the plan but you can ask to get to this destiny. What type of skills and training and certification will I need? You can begin to read books on it to see and to be able to gain knowledge in that area.

The third one is how to run, how to run. God told pastor to run a half marathon every other month for his health's sake. And when he runs, he runs a pre-planned path. His run has several qualities that are the same qualities that you'll need with your run. Number one, His run is timed. So, He knows exactly every race He's won. He can tell you how long it took Him to run it. It's a timed thing. And that's why with goals, you need to put a time on your actions, because if you don't put a time on it, tomorrow will never come.

The second quality on His runs is He has a consistent pace with a cadence and He tracks His pace when He is practicing for the run on the treadmill so He'll know how long He wants to take in this run and He will calculate that down to a certain speed. He'll dial that in on the treadmill and begin to practice His cadence on that run so He doesn't run out of breathe and then get too tired.

The next quality he has with His run is He runs the race together with somebody else. And He learned in His last race, He had a better time because He ran with a faster group. So, He began to look at different groups and see who was moving at the pace that He wanted to finish it. And when He got with a faster group, it kept Him motivated. Because when He wanted to fall behind, he said, "No, I got to keep up with this group here." If you're running with somebody slow, you'll get lax and you'll look at yourself out in front of them and feel good. But if you're running with a group and you fall in behind, it will motivate you to catch up. So, be careful who you run with because it will help determine your pace.

The next quality is you have to endure to the end. It doesn't matter how fast you start of when the whistle blows. It matters about Him finishing at the finish line. You don't get credit for

running the race until you cross that finish line. You all have seen the t-shirts they give you. You don't get the t-shirt if you stop, "Hey, wait." And say, "I'm going to the car, I did my best." You get the t-shirt once you finish at the finish line. You have to run until the end. And you need all three steps in order to make it to your promised land.

If you have wrong vision and a good plan and good action, you'll end up achieving the wrong thing. If you have a wrong plan but have good vision and good action, you'll get frustrated that your actions aren't producing the correct results leading to the vision. If you have a lack of action but you have good vision and a good plan, your vision will end up turning into a dream. It will never come into fruition.

A business associate of mine, he used these three steps to get a perfect score on SAT of 1600. He got a perfect credit score of 850 and he wrote a book and took it to number one in its category on Amazon Kindle. And he did it just using the same three steps. So, it wasn't anything complicated. So when you set the vision say, "I want to make a perfect SAT score." He looked at the research and saw how many hours he needed to get better and get to perfection. And he just began doing an hour work to practice problems a day. And whenever he would get something wrong, he had our strategy. He would look up and see how to do it right and begin to correct one formula after another and one thing after another. And after a few years, he'd gotten where he had made a perfect score.

Same thing on his credit, so He didn't start off with perfect credit but He did the research to see what are the components of having great credit. And then, He began to order a credit report every month and look at those negative factors and began to pay around these credit cards and began to reduce this debt here. He began to follow whatever it said on at each month and chip away with it one action at a time and He ended up with an 850. He wrote a book and said, "I wanted to go to number one." And He read up on how to market and get this book to number one. He developed this marketing campaign that marketed the book for Him, day in and day out automated and He began to go at number one.

So, He used the same three principles to go to the very top, three different things. Two of the most innovative CEOs now are Tesla's Elon Musk, and Amazon's Jeff Bezos. Tesla's value recently surpassed that of any American auto company including Ford and GM. And they are also the two individuals in the world that are making plans right now to colonize Mars. So, what I saw from them in common that even when the ordinary couldn't understand them, they could see the farthest vision. They not only sold decades into the future but they looked 34 million miles away at Mars and said, "I'm going to begin to strategize of how -- not only to get goods to people here in America and across this world." But Amazon said, "I want to deliver goods to people when they get to Mars." They already began to build rocket ships to be able to supply goods on Mars. This is so far from our ordinary minds but they have this extended vision of what they can see and they begin to make plans. So, not just a vain vision but they have a blueprint of exactly how they're going to do it, and they began to take action.

God gave my wife and I the vision to have seven kids. Believe me, it wasn't our vision. It was not our plan but it was here and I had to pray, "Lord, we need a plan and a strategy. We know how to have them but we need to know how to take care of them." And He has given us strategies to be able to raise them and be able to school them where we can afford. One day we'll have four kids in college simultaneously and I have a vision to get it paid for without debt. But I can't just have a vision or a goal all of it, I have to have a strategy that goes along with it. And part of my strategy involves them keeping a certain GPA. So, I had to put in (00:22:52) in place, tutoring in place to motivate them. And whenever they fall behind in a subject, I have to get them up to speed quick. Part of the strategy, I have to develop a calculator to calculate their GPA according to how the Hobbs(ph) Scholarship calculate. I couldn't find it out there. I had to write it as part of a strategy.

And part of the strategy is they have to make a certain SAT, so I have to get a strategy to get them trained on that end. They've all began training for the SAT. Strategy has worked so far with the first three that have reached that state. All three has made over 1,100 on just the Math and Reading, so it is working. But I had to have a strategy not just a vision. And these last two steps of writing that strategic plan and executing that plan, running in excellence is where most Christians fail. They have the faith that

God can accomplish the same but they lack the discipline to do their portion, and that's why the system falls apart.

There are only a few circumstances that I've seen God dropped a big blessing on somebody without them doing anything. But even in those situations, it's still to diligence in order to maintain that blessing. And I had someone that was co-worker with me at one time, God gave her a vision on her dream and He showed how much money she will make coming out of college and it was in the fashion industry. And she brought the vision to me and said, "This is what God has shown me." And I listened to it and began to advise her. And I said that, "You know it's no accident. He has placed you with a family that just so happened to produce the largest fashion show in the country right now and you've got a destiny in this fashion industry."

So, at our next fashion show, I connected her with three of the top fashion designers in the city. And I went on her behalf and said that, "You know, I have worked with her and I would recommend her. And if you have any internships, can you mentor her? God has a great vision for her."

And they agreed to do it because of my relationship with them, three different designers.

I came back a few months later to the young lady. I said, "How was it going with those hookups there?" And she hadn't called anyone of them back. She said, "God is going to do it." And she didn't accomplish any of the vision, any of the missions because she couldn't see that God had given her the resources, the plans, the strategy to get it done and she was waiting on Him to do the portion that He had placed for her to do. And so many Christians make this mistake. They have faith that God is going to do this thing but they don't use the resources that God has given them. They don't go back and pray to God. Say, "Lord, show me the strategies on how to do this. Give me your plans." That's why we missed it so many times. In the Bible, there are many examples of this see, write and run process. The Walls of Jericho is one. The children of Ezra had a vision that God gave them to take the city to get to their promised land. They had been in the wilderness for 40 years. That was their vision. The plan and the strategy that God gave them was to walk around this wall once a

day for six days holding their peace with their mouth, on the seventh day, to walk seven times. And then, give a shout and blow their trumpets. That brought the walls tumbling down where they could overtake the city. Nehemiah was a man that operated these three principles. God gave them the vision to restore the honor and protection of Jerusalem, gave them the plan to rebuild the walls and He gave them the strategy to let half of the people serve as watchmen on the wall as soldiers, half of the people built and worked with one hand and with a weapon in the other hand.

Joseph, he gave Pharaoh a vision in a dream. But He used Joseph and gave him the interpretation of the dream, gave him the strategy of how to keep the people through the farmer that ended up delivering a whole nation of people. Jesus, He had a vision to save the whole world. God gave Him the strategy that He had to lay down His life for us, give up His life so that our lives might be saved. And He had a strategy to train these disciples that would spread His teachings all over the world. And He had to go and run and live a perfect life and endure the torture at the end.

How many of you have had product ideas and years later, you see it on the market and say, "You know I had that idea. I didn't do anything with it. Wow! They stole my idea." And I tell you, in business and life, you don't get paid for having the vision or the idea first. You get paid for executing it first. And even if you want to get a patent on an idea, it still requires those next two steps because you got to draw it out. You can't just verbally recall the ideas that, "You know, I got an idea for this new hair product." And just get a pay. You got to write it down. You've got to draw diagrams of this thing. You've got to hire a lawyer and pay \$5,000 to \$10,000 to file it. So, you've got to still go through writing it and running with it just to even protect the idea.

And even in the natural, if you want to borrow money from a bank to start a business, they don't want to just hear the vision. You can't just come in and sit at the desk and say, "This is what God has given me for this restaurant." They're going to say, "Where is your business plan?" They want to see it in writing. They want to see your strategies in print. When I got ready for a wife, I had to write out exactly the qualities that I was looking for in a woman even before I pray for God to send it. I had to write out what I wanted Him to send and sure enough He sent me Ms. Tiffany right here.

And I tell you, if you don't know where you're going, any road will take you there. And even with driving to get to a destination, you have to know where you're going and you have to plot out the route to get there. Then, you've got to make the drive, the same three things. Knowing where you're going is the vision, plotting the route is the writing, and driving is the running. And even with our show, God gave me a vision of even saving souls right there in the midst of our show floor. And then, I prayed for the strategy of how to do it and He showed me that people's phones will run out and showed me a sign and say, "Come in and charge your phone for free while you charge your spirit." And we placed free charging stations. And Reverend Earl Tillman over 30 people just in the last show, God saved and gave their lives to God right there on the exhibit floor. So, God will give you the vision. But then, you need to go back and pray for the strategy of how to implement the vision. And then, you need to put in the work to make it come to pass.

Amen.

With heads bowed right now, I want to say a special prayer at the altar for those that you know that God has given you a vision. You know that He's called you for a higher purpose in what you're walking in right now. And if you have not written it out in a detailed plan, if you're not running with it and taking actions, begin to do it. You know what needs to be done to make this vision come into fruition. And if you want to make a commitment today, to write it down on paper this week, to begin to take actions this week after hearing this word, this quickening something in your spirit, just come to the altar and we just want to make a new commitment and pray over you this day.

We don't have to ask Prophet Dexter to call you out. You know when God has given you a vision. God will give you the vision but He will not write it out. He will not run it for you. He has given you legs and hands to run with. He has given you a hand to write it out with. And if you know that it's you this day, come and make a new commitment. And as you come, just begin to pray in your own space there making your own commitment. And then, I will say a corporate prayer over you once everybody comes. We want you to get to that place called there. Too many, God's children

spinning their wheels, day in and day out, stuck in job and in position that they know something on the inside that God has called them for more in their lives. He has called this as a day of change, a day of moving into the new season, new place.

I'm going to pray in three sections. For this first section, I want you to just place your hands over your eyes right where you stand.

Lord, right now, I pray that you will allow your children's hands to become your hands, O Lord, that you will touch their eyes, O Lord, beyond the physical, O Lord, into the spiritual eyes, O Father. I pray, O Lord, that by the power of your Holy Ghost, O Father, that you will give them clear and correct vision right now, O Lord. Those things, O Lord, that have been foggy, O Lord, when they haven't known quite what to do, O Lord, or quite how to bring it to pass, O Lord. I pray, O Father, for vision to come onto these eyes, O Lord, that I touched right now, O Father.

I pray, O Lord, for bond as to be removed, O Father, the clarity to come, O father. We pray, O Lord, for a spiritual 20/20, O Lord. Upon these eyes, O Lord, where there are spiritual cataracts, O Lord, we call them to be removed, O Lord. Where there are spiritual scales, O Lord, we call them right now in the name of Jesus to fall off, O Lord, of these eyes, O Lord. I call for vision, O Lord, to be clarified in your people, O Father, that they'll see the plans, O Lord, that you have for them with clarity, O Lord, with correctness, O Father.

For the second prayer, I want you to just take your writing hand and just began to write in the air as you're writing a plan. Lord, I pray, O Father, that your people's plans will not be their plans, but they'll be your plans, O Father.

I pray, O Lord, for innovative strategies, O Lord, to come into their lives this week, O Father, that as they follow the infraction, O Lord, that you sent this day, O Lord. I pray that you'll make it easy, O Lord, as they sit with paper and pen, O Lord. I pray that you'll begin to let it flow, O Father, easier than it's ever flown before, O Father. I pray, O Lord, that you'll let them write with spiritual hands, O Lord, those things that have been pinned up on the inside of them, O Lord, is just a vision, O Lord. I pray, O Lord, that you will begin to bring it out plainly as a plan, O Father. This week, O Lord, we pray, O Father, for you to stop, O

Lord, those plans within them, O Lord. Lord, your plan, not our plan, O Lord, Your will, not our will, O Lord.

I pray, O Lord, that we submit our spirits, O Father, as we prepare for your plan, O Lord, that we will lay down, O Lord, what we want, O Lord, but we'll declare this day, O Lord, that we are living for you, O Father. That, Lord, we give you our hands, O Lord. We give you our talents, O Lord, from which they came, O Lord. We give it back onto you as a sacrifice, O Lord, as a living sacrifice upon the altar this day, O Lord. Write your plans through us, O Lord. Write your plans through us this week, O Lord. Write your plans through us, O Father.

For this last segment, I want you to just jog in place right where you are.

Lord, as your people, pick up one leg and another, O Lord, as they begin to run, O Lord. I pray, O Lord, that you'll give them energy, O Lord, that you'll refresh them, O Lord, those that are tired, O Lord, those that have been depressed, O Lord, those that have been discouraged, O Father.

I pray, O Lord, that you'll awaken, O Father, a new energy, a new fervor, O Lord. Those that are running out of wind, O Father, we pray for our second wind of the spirit, O Father, that you'll give them the wind, O Father, of the Holy Ghost, O Lord, to be able to complete, O Lord, the vision, to complete the race, O Lord. The race goes not to the swift, O Father, not to the strong, but he that endures it to the end, O Father.

I pray for endurance in your people, O Lord, a spiritual endurance, O Lord, that when attacks of the enemy come, O Lord, that they'll all endure, O Lord, when those around them that can't see the vision will try to speak negativity on their life.
